Conneaut School District will participate in the statewide Spring 2025-2026 Keystone Exams on May 11 – 22, 2026. The Keystone Exams are end-of-course assessments designed to evaluate proficiency in academic content. The Winter and Spring Keystone Exams retest those students who are not successful in one or more modules in the past.

Section 4.4 of Title 22, Chapter 4 provides for the right of parents (or guardians) to excuse their children from the state assessment, if upon inspection of the testing materials, they find the assessment to be in conflict with their religious beliefs. This is the only basis for a parental excusal from the statewide assessments. After reviewing the test(s) parents (guardians) must provide a written request addressed to Dr. Adam Jardina, Superintendent, for excusal based upon religious conflict. If you wish to review the assessment forms, please contact your child's school by April 24th, 2026 and make arrangements with Mr. Vannoy and the School Assessment Coordinator.
