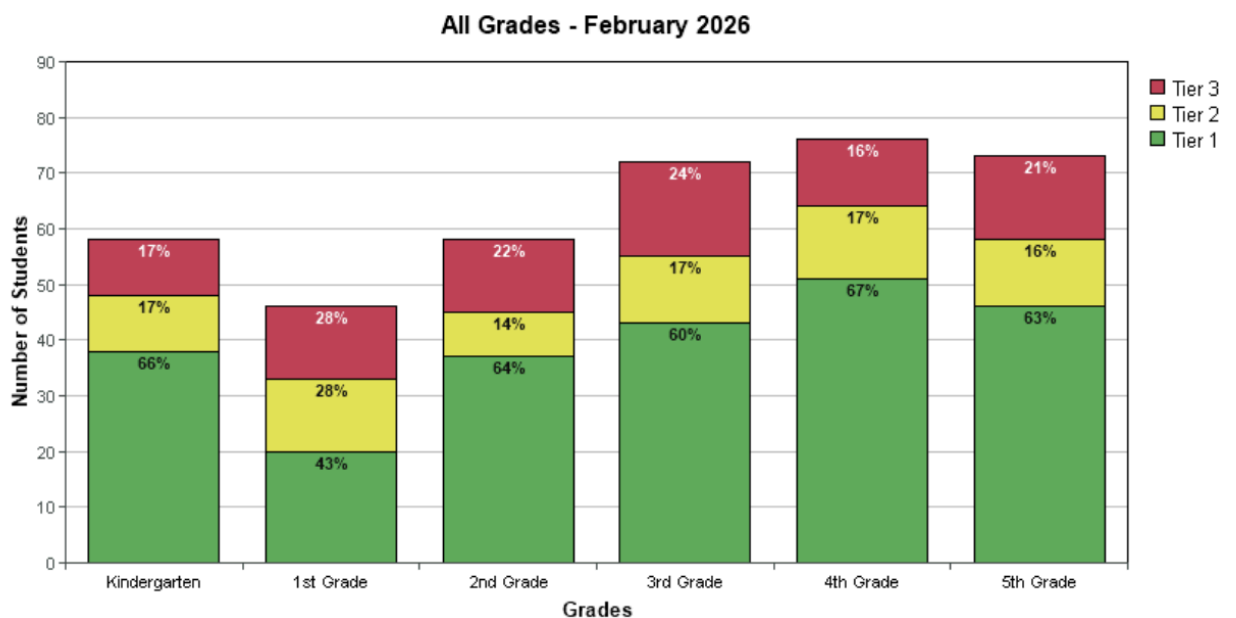
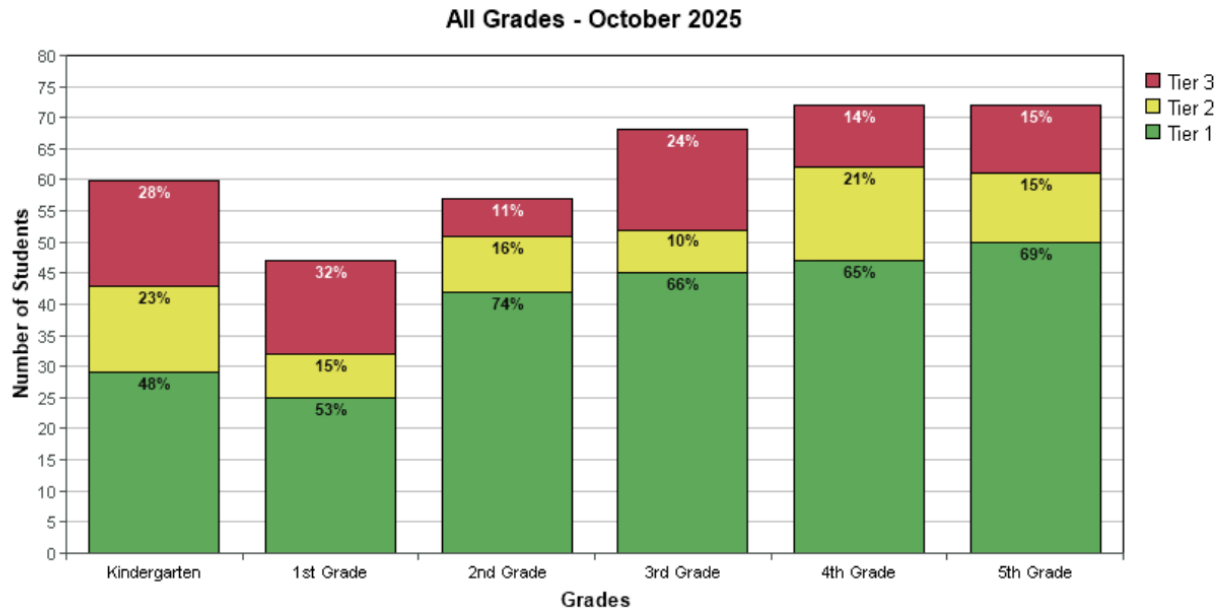

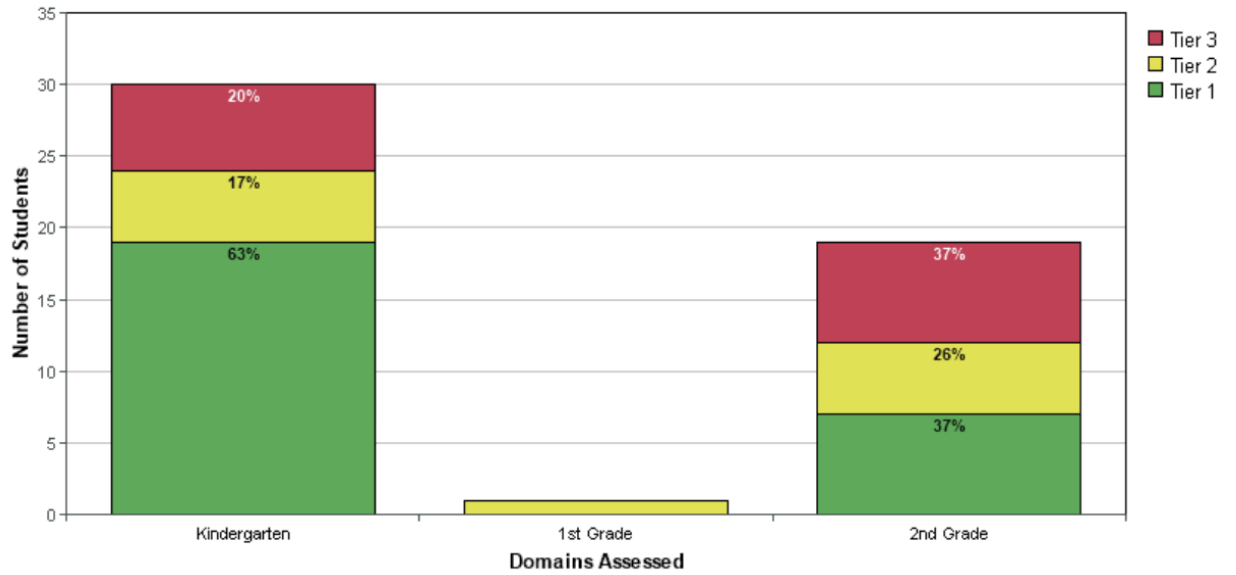
★ **ISIP Reading Scores** - 4th and 5th are using IXL to Benchmark students for the fall and will use their diagnostic scores to watch progress.



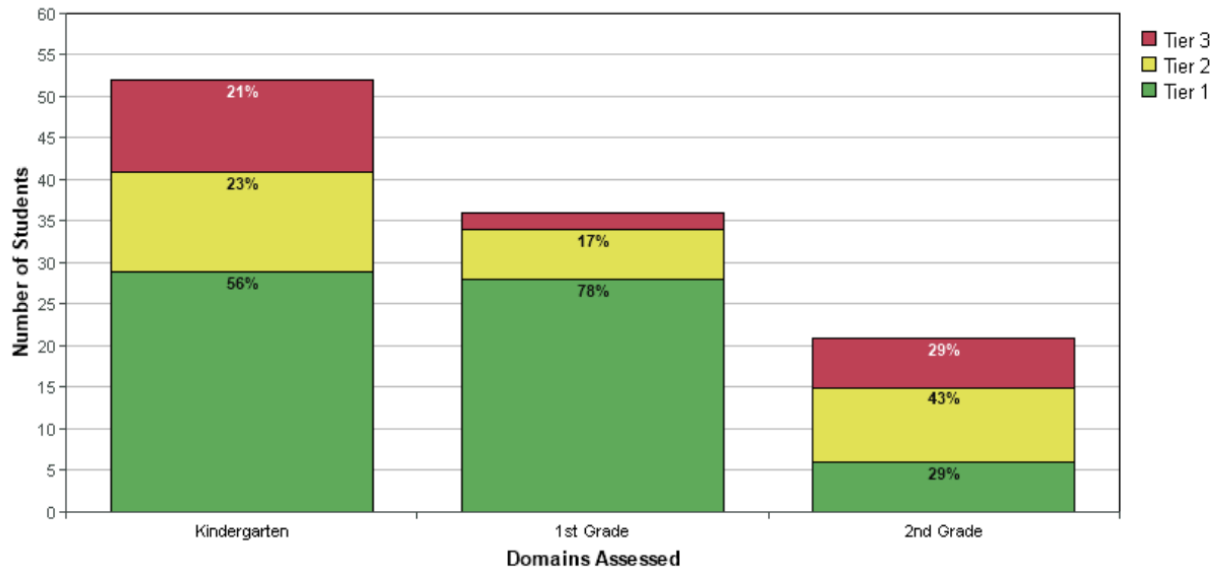

★ **ISIP Math Scores**

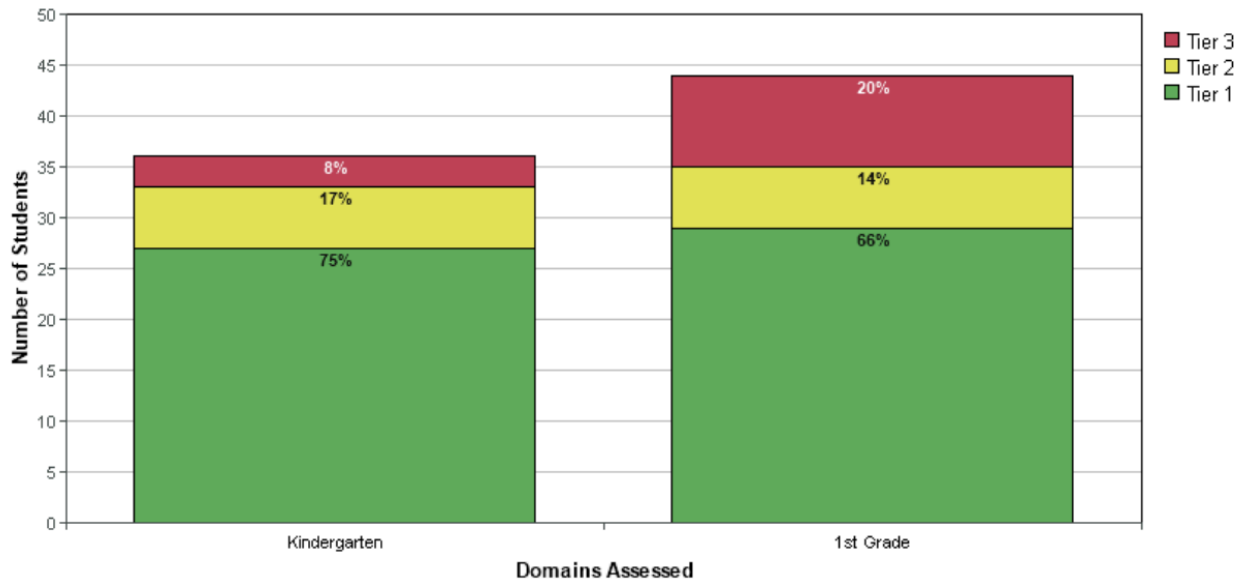
All Grades - October 2025



All Grades - December 2025



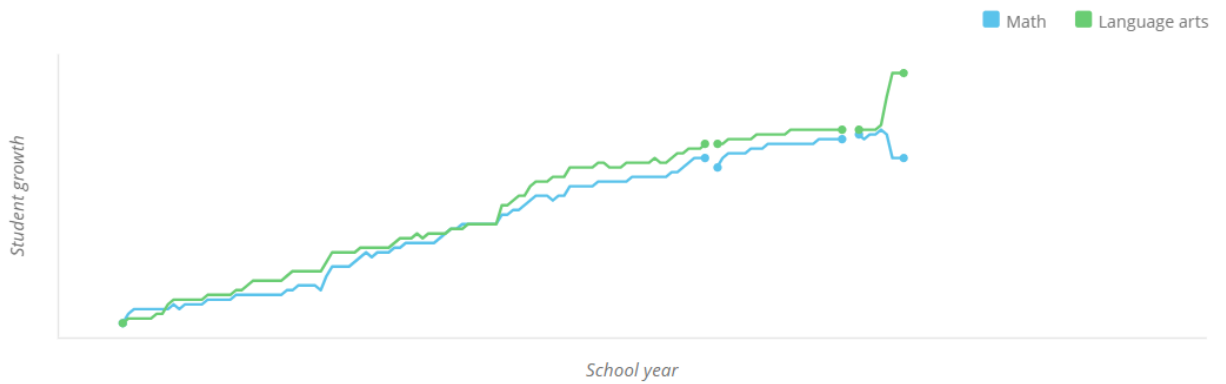
All Grades - February 2026



Kinder also tested in February on the Math ISIP. Kinder is up 15% from December testing and it looks like 1st grade is down 11%.

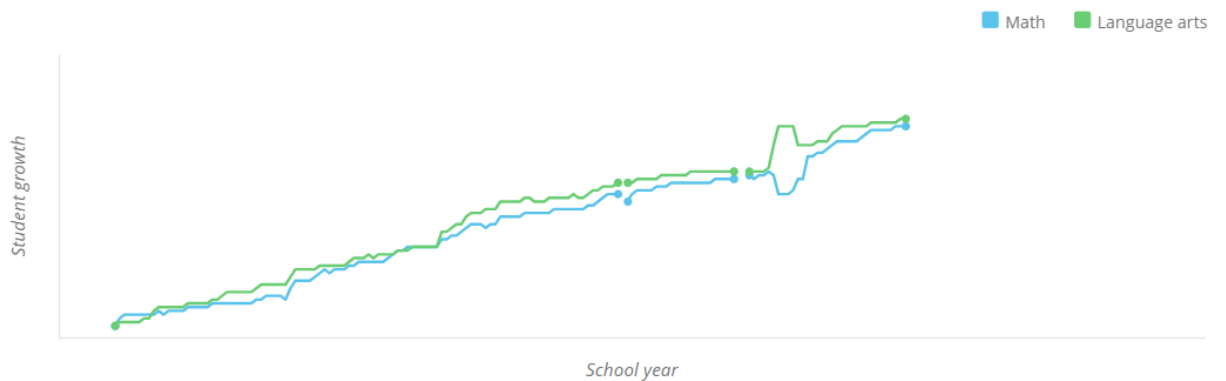
★ IXL Overall Growth

OVERALL GROWTH

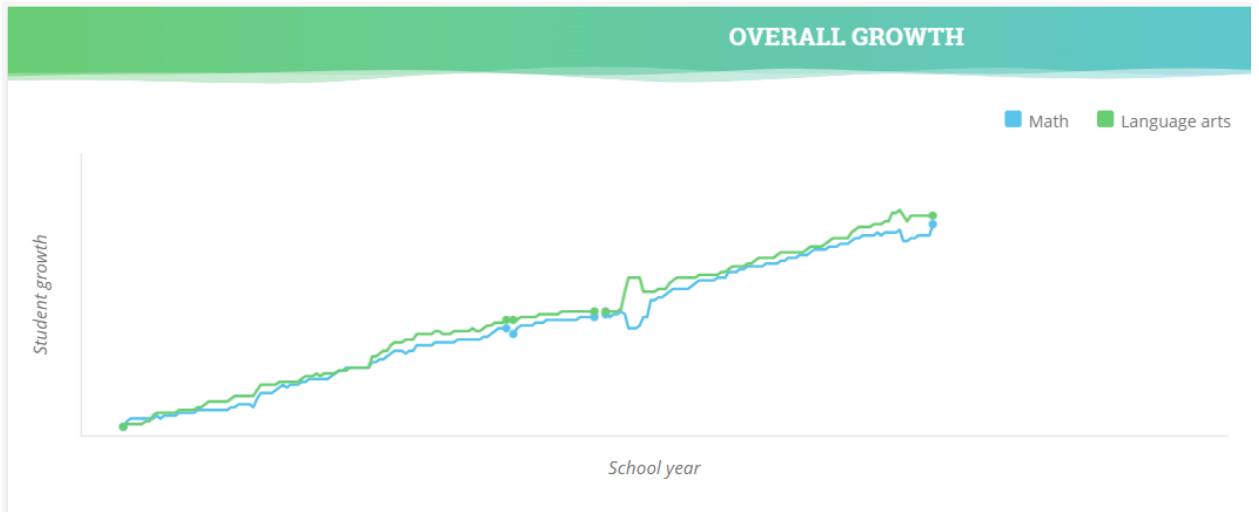


December 2025
