

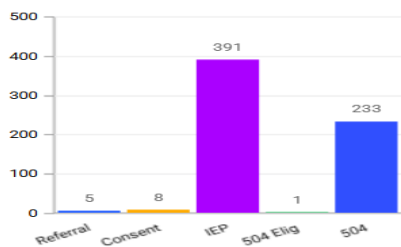


Special Education Monthly Board Report Emmett School District April, 2026

Special Education Demographics:

As of April 9, 2026, the home page of our IEP platform (Edplan) shows that 391 students are receiving Special Education, with an additional 5 Referrals and 8 Consents for Evaluation.

Department Projects:

District special education staff are actively engaged in transition meetings to support students moving between buildings for the upcoming school year. This includes:

- Preschool students transitioning to Kindergarten
- 5th grade students transitioning from elementary schools to East Middle School (EMS)
- 8th grade students transitioning to high school
- Additional students transitioning between buildings as needed

These transition meetings are designed to ensure continuity of services, proactive planning, and appropriate supports for each student, with a particular focus on students receiving Special Education services.

Special Education Professional Development Update

Special Education teachers have been exploring the use of MagicSchool AI to enhance their instructional planning and documentation practices. This includes identifying ways to:

- Streamline progress monitoring
- Develop meaningful and measurable IEP goals
- Create targeted skill practice aligned to student needs
- Design lesson plans connected to both IEP goals and general education standards
