



# High School Summer School 2026



The School District of South Milwaukee will be offering credit recovery and limited phy ed initial credit summer school courses for current high school students. This document provides the necessary information and directions for summer school Course Registration through Infinite Campus. Should you have any questions after reviewing this documentation, please contact your student's school counselor.

<p>All summer school courses will include the following components:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All students will need a <u>charged</u> Chromebook.</li><li>• Students can and should enroll in as many sessions as needed to recover deficient credits and stay on track for graduation.</li><li>• Attendance is taken and mandatory during summer school.</li><li>• <b><u>Students taking initial credit Phy Ed can only miss 2 days in order to stay on track to earn credit.</u></b></li></ul>	<p><b>Summer School Registration:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Must be completed through Infinite Campus Course Registration process (see below)</li><li>• Opens April 17, 2026</li></ul> <p><b>Summer School Schedules:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Available via Infinite Campus in early June</li></ul>

# High School Summer Course Information

## Initial Credit Courses

**Phy Ed** (*grades 10-12*) (0.5 credit): These courses offer students an opportunity to earn initial credit in either Team Concepts or Outdoor Activities. The courses meet during three periods for the entire 6-week summer session. Attendance is mandatory for completion of this course for credit. **NOTE:** Students may not repeat a Phy Ed strand for initial credit. [Course #: 7532S or 7533S]

## Credit Recovery Courses

**English CR** (*grades 9-12*) (0.5 or 1.0 credits): Students who received a failing grade for either S1 or S2 in English 9, English 10, Composition, Diverse Voices in Literature, Journalism, Media Studies, or Themes in Literature/Writing will have the opportunity to recover deficient credits.

**Math CR** (*grades 9-12*) (0.5 or 1.0 credits): Students who received a failing grade for Algebra, Geometry, Algebra 2, Financial Algebra, Statistics & Probability, Technical Math or Transition to College Math will have the opportunity to recover deficient credits.

**Phy Ed - Intro Phy Ed-CR** (*grades 9-12*) (0.5 credits): Students who received a failing grade for Introduction to Phy Ed will have the opportunity to recover deficient credits. [Course #: 7510CR]

**Phy Ed - Self, Team or Outdoor CR** (*grades 10-12*) (0.5 credits): Students who received a failing grade for Self Enhancement, Team Concepts or Outdoor Activity will have the opportunity to recover deficient credits. [Course #: 7531CR, 7532CR, 7533CR]

**Science CR** (*grades 9-12*) (0.5 or 1.0 credits): Students who received a failing grade for either S1 or S2 in Biology, Biology Accl, Chemistry, Environmental Science, or Physical Science will have the opportunity to recover deficient credits.

**Social Studies CR** (*grades 9-12*) (0.5 or 1.0 credits): Students who received a failing grade for either S1 or S2 in American Government, Pre-AP World History, or US History will have the opportunity to recover deficient credits.

## Enrichment / Non-Credit Courses

**Speed, Strength & Agility** (*grades 8-12*): This course is geared toward overall athletic development for all high school athletes, regardless of the sport in which they participate. The purpose of this class is to assist student-athletes to improve in the areas of speed, power, agility, and flexibility.

**Two sessions of the course are offered:**

Session One: 6:30-7:30 AM

Session Two: 3:00-4:00 PM.

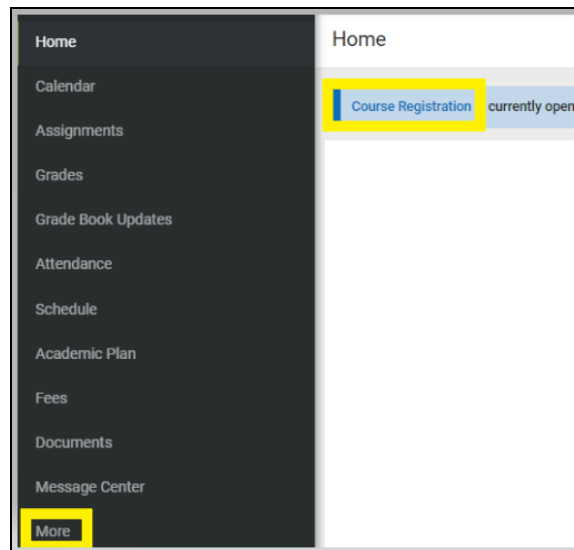

# Course Registration Instructions - Infinite Campus

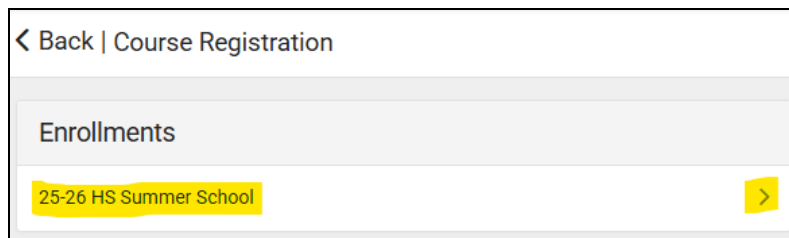
**Step 1** Log into your Infinite Campus account ([Students](#) or [Parent/Guardian](#))

**Parent/Guardian:** If you have multiple students in the district, you will need to select the student you are completing course registration for.

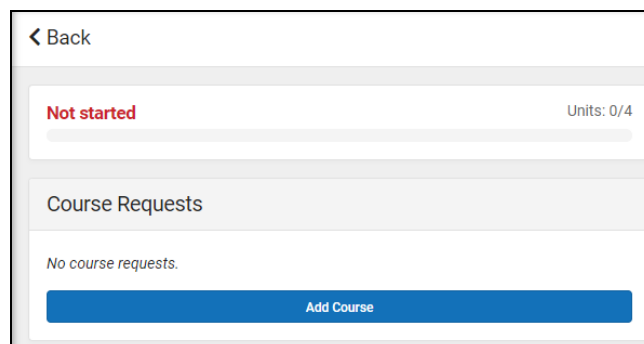
**Step 2** Click on [Course Registration](#) OR from the left side menu, select More and then Course Registration from the pop up.



**Step 3** Click on **25-26 HS Summer School** to open the Course Requests page.



**Step 4** Select Add Course to view summer school course options.

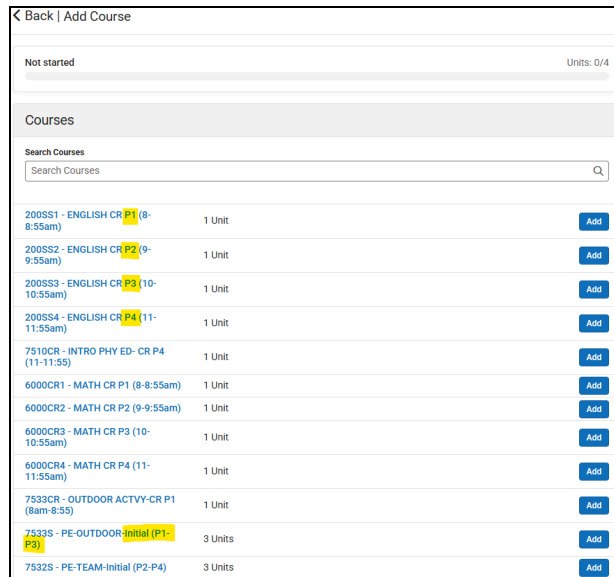

Summer School course names indicate the period and time the course meets. CR indicates it is a Credit Recovery course, not for initial credit.



**Step 5** Select summer school courses:

- Click on the Add button or click on the course name to see a description of the course.
  - A pop out menu will appear asking if you want to add the course as a Request or Alternate.
  - Choose Request. *Please do not add Alternate courses to summer school registration.*
- Once the Request has been submitted, the status bar will populate with a percent complete.
- Continue selecting your needed courses for Credit Recovery or Initial Credit. Pay attention to the timing of each course.
- If you make a mistake and want to change a course, bring up the list of courses and click the Delete button.
  - A pop up menu will display asking you to delete the request. Or click on the course name and select Delete Request at the bottom of the screen.
- When the needed courses have been selected, click Back at the top of the window to see all requested courses. The percent complete will automatically be calculated based on the number of course request units.
- Students are encouraged, but not required, to select as many courses as needed to recover deficient credits. This will ensure students stay on track to complete graduation requirements.
- ***At this point, verify the requested courses do not overlap periods.***
