1. **Framing the Work** Committee
 - a. Review and approval of the agenda

2. **Updates and Discussion Items** Committee
 - a. [Policy 5300](#): Code of Conduct: Preparation for April 8 [review](#)
The committee agreed that they would divide the policy into sections and assign certain sections to each member for revision. The intention is to complete the review by summer 2026 and adoption prior to the start of the 2026-27 school year.
 - b. [Policy 1050](#): Annual District Election and Budget Vote
Although the NYSSBA Policy Service has not yet updated the policy to align with the new law, the district has modified its practices to align with the law.
 - c. Policy 8121.2: Automated External Defibrillators - alignment of practices and facilities use plans.
 - d. [Policy 8130.2](#): Workplace Violence Prevention - update on requirements
K. Slentz provided the committee with information on how administration has revised district practices to align with law and policy.
 - e. Policy 8636: Artificial Intelligence - update from recent meetings
The committee reviewed the work that had been completed by the AI subcommittee of the Curriculum Advisory Council and a draft policy that incorporated this work. The committee agreed to more fully review it at an upcoming April committee meeting.
