The Blueprint for the Future is the strategic plan for Gwinnett County Public Schools. This plan is organized into four strategic priorities, each with three specific goals. To ensure success, these goals have clear objectives and Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) to track and measure progress. Each year schools review their data to identify areas for growth and set long-term goals to improve them. This information is used to create a Local School Plan for Improvement (LSPI) aligned to the district's priorities. OUR SCHOOL GOALS

We will provide all students with high quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment to meet high academic standards.

At Partee ES, 100% of the students in K-5TH grade will achieve one year of reading growth as measured by the iReady screener.

All our students will meet or exceed the standard for writing, and at least 50% will exceed on the standard for writing. Our K-5 students will demonstrate expected or high growth in the GCPS Common Formative Assessment in the area of Math.

The specific academic skills that Partee Elementary will be focusing on this year are:

- Language Arts-Reading fluency and comprehension
