RE: ANNUAL ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION LETTER ~ School Year 2025- 2026

In October of 1986 the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) regulations were enacted, Public Law 99-519. AHERA mandated that EPA develop regulations to respond to asbestos in schools. On October 30, 1987, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) promulgated the Asbestos-Containing Materials in Schools rule, 40 CFR Part 763, Subpart E. This regulation requires school districts, both public and private, to inspect their buildings for asbestos containing materials (ACM) and develop management plans to address potential hazards, in accordance with EPA regulations and guidance policy.

A copy of our district's Asbestos Management Plan is available in each school and at the District's Office of Facilities and Grounds during regular school hours.

It is the policy of this school that Asbestos Containing Materials (ACM) will not be disturbed, replaced, or removed by school personnel.
