

WHAT IS DUAL ENROLLMENT?

- Opportunity for Juniors and Seniors to take college courses to earn both high school and college credit.
- Most DE courses are taken as asynchronous online courses, but some may be in-person.

DE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Be a rising Junior or Senior
2. Meet one of the requirements below:
 - 3.0 unweighted GPA; ACT English = 18; ACT Reading = 19
 - 3.6 unweighted GPA (no test scores required)

TSAC DE GRANT

- The DE Grant pays tuition for 5 total DE courses.
- For classes 6-10, the DE Grant will pay \$100 per credit hour (Pellissippi courses cost \$185/credit hour)
- To stay eligible, students must maintain a 2.0 GPA

WHAT COLLEGES OFFER DE?

Most FHS students take DE classes through:

- Pellissippi State
- ETSU
- TCAT (TN College of Applied Technology)

KCS also has DE Agreements with several other colleges. UTK does not offer DE courses.

COURSE OFFERINGS

DE COURSE CATALOG

The DE Course Catalog is a list of the most common courses taken by FHS students. However, students can take any course they meet the prerequisites for.

SCHEDULING

- Indicating you would like to take a DE course in ASPEN does not guarantee enrollment
- DE courses will be put on FHS schedules AFTER students submit proof of course enrollment
- Asynchronous online classes can be scheduled during any FHS block
- In-person classes may only be scheduled 1st or 4th block (before 10:00 or after 2:00)

IMPORTANT NOTES!

- FHS does not have access to DE grades. Students are responsible for monitoring their own grades.
- Students may not withdraw from a DE course once classes start. Withdrawing will result in an "F" on the FHS transcript
- DE courses add 1 quality point to the weighted GPA
