April 14, 2026 Special Meeting

At the April 14, 2026 Special Meeting of the School Board, the Central Bucks Board of School Directors:

Announced the purpose of the Special Meeting: To appoint a new district superintendent for a five-year term and to approve an employment contract with the newly appointed district superintendent.

Appointed Joanna M. Wexler, Ph.D. Central Bucks School District Superintendent for a five-year term beginning July 1, 2026 and approved the District Superintendent Employment Agreement with Joanna M. Wexler, Ph.D., effective July 1, 2026 with an annual starting salary of \$255,000.00.

Heard Public Comment:

1. Art Larson, Doylestown, congratulated Dr. Wexler. Mr. Larson offered to help audit district finances. Mr. Larson spoke about tax increases, lawsuits, insurance, infiltration, the Make-A-Wish Foundation, crime syndicates and organized crime.

2. Jason O'Donnell, Buckingham, spoke about DEI. Mr. O'Donnell encouraged the Board to discontinue including diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI) into policy. Mr. O'Donnell spoke about discrimination and speaking and acting in ways that are blind to race, gender, religion, and sexual orientation. Mr. O'Donnell encouraged the Board to focus on education.
