

Below, you will find the instructions for the summer work for Enhanced Algebra:

1. Use the link below to access the Khan Academy Course.
 - <https://www.khanacademy.org/join/KTSMKRMP>
 - If at any point you are asked for a course code, it is **KTSMKRMP**
2. Complete the assigned Mastery Goal. It is as follows:
 - Complete Unit 1: Get ready for equations & inequalities to 80% mastery.
 - Complete Unit 3: Get ready for linear relationships to 80% mastery
 - Complete Unit 4: Get ready for functions and sequences to 80% mastery.

You are not required to complete the entire course to 80% mastery, only these three units. I encourage you to complete the Course Challenge before you begin the units to help speed up your progress. See the screenshot below for an example of how to tell when you have reached 80% in a unit.
