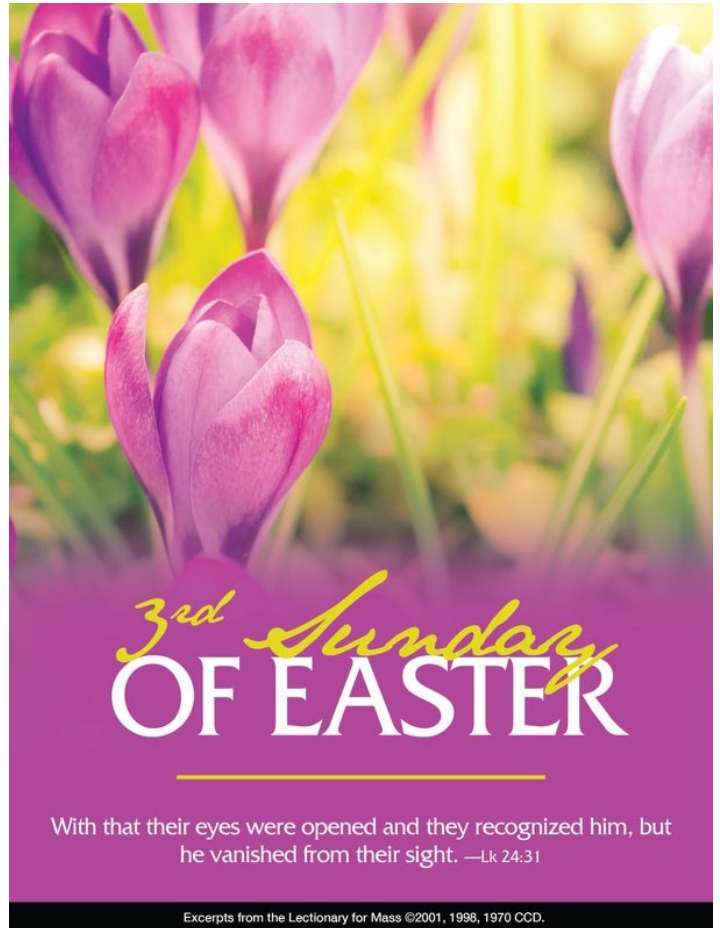

Behold the Lamb Quick Weekly Lessons on the Sacred Liturgy



As the Priest offers up to God the *oblation*—Christ the Son—to the Father on our behalf, he also offers up in union with Christ, the needs and petitions of the whole Church and those we bring in the *intercessions*. As Christ is our intercessor before the Father in Heaven, so the Priest, acting in the person of Christ, intercedes before the Father (in the Holy Spirit) praying for the repose of the souls of the faithful departed, unity and peace in the Church and throughout the world, our own sanctification, the salvation of the world, and the Pope, Bishop and all the clergy. In this, we realize that when we celebrate the Eucharist, we celebrate it with the entire Church, both living and dead and we are called to “participate in the redemption and salvation purchased by the Body and Blood of Christ,” (GIRM, 79g) bringing Christ to the world as we receive Him here in the Eucharist.

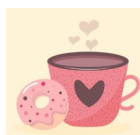

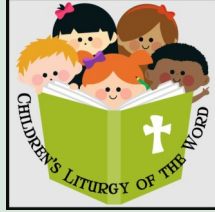
