FAQ Concerning Stillwater Public Schools Tax Exempt Status

Are donations to Stillwater Public Schools (SPS) considered tax deductible?

Yes. Per IRS Publication 526 a contribution to a qualified organization may be tax deductible to individuals and corporations. Stillwater Public Schools fits the definition of an organization that qualifies to receive deductible contributions as a "political subdivision of a state".

Is SPS a charitable organization? What is your 501(c)(3) number?

Stillwater Public Schools is a political subdivision of the state of Oklahoma and political subdivisions are qualified organization per the internal revenue code to receive tax deductible contributions.

A charitable organization is described in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is a separate type of qualified organization that is also eligible to receive tax deductible contributions. A public school district does not have to have a 501(c)(3) designation because they are already considered a qualified organization to receive tax deductible contributions under a separate definition.
