Dear AP Students & Families:

AP exams will be administered from May 4th – May 15th. The exam schedule is listed below. Please review it carefully for times and dates. If you have any questions regarding the schedule please contact us immediately. The a.m. exams begin at 8:00 a.m. sharp and the p.m. exams begin at 12:00 p.m. **Please arrive 20 minutes before each exam administration.** The exams typically take approximately four hours to administer.

Also, we would like to review with you a few important items regarding guidelines for Advanced Placement Examinations.

Students **should** bring the following items to the exam(s):

- A fully charged chromebook along with charging cord
- Two sharpened pencils with erasers & two ballpoint pens (black or dark blue)
- Calculators - visit: <https://apstudents.collegeboard.org/exam-policies-guidelines/calculator-policies> to find the correct calculator for your subject
- A ruler or straight-edge if you are taking the AP Physics Exam
- A watch that does not have internet access, beep or make noise, or have alarm access

Students **should not** bring the following items to the exam(s):

- Any other electronic or communication devices
- Electronic equipment including cell phones, smartwatches, fitness trackers, wearable technology, cameras, recording or listening devices, or any electronic communication device. A student observed with any of these devices during testing or breaks may be dismissed from the exam and his/her test will be invalidated.
- Books, reference guides, notes, compasses, protractors, dictionaries, highlighters, or colored pencils
- Watches that beep or have alarms
- Food and/or drink
- **Backpacks will not be allowed in the testing room or the hallways outside of the testing room. Please leave them at home or store them in your locker.**

Finally, if you are absent for either all or part of an exam day, a written excuse from your parent/guardian must be provided. Students are expected to attend classes before and after exams.
