**Rules and Regulations, Formal Dress Code Policy, and Dance Policy Guidelines**

**Salesian College Preparatory - Dance Guest Pass Request**

***PROM: Garden of Olympus***

Sunday, April 26, 2026: 7:00 p.m. - 11:00 p.m.

At **BLOCK 15 - 252 2nd Street, Oakland, CA 94607**

1. The Junior/Senior PROM is from 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. **The doors close at 7:30pm p.m. and reopen at 11:00p.m. NO ONE will be allowed to enter or exit the dance after 7:30pm.**
2. **Guest tickets must be purchased by April 22.** Tickets will not be sold at the door.
3. **Completed Guest Dance Pass Request forms must be submitted by April 23** to Ms. Rivera, SCP Associate Principal of Social Excellence.
4. Each Salesian student may bring only ONE guest. Freshman and Sophomore students are not allowed to attend, even if they are SCP students, as a guest. The guest must not be 21 or older. Please see Ms. Rivera, Associate Principal, for any exceptions to this rule.
5. **Student guests must bring a current photo ID to the dance.** Guests will not be permitted into the dance without their ID or without their host present.

**Formal Dress Code Policy: The PROM is a formal dance.**

**Acceptable Formal Dress:**

- Dress shirt, dress pants, suit jacket, blazer, and tie.
- Appropriate length skirts and dresses may be worn. These garments must be mid-thigh length or longer. Dresses may be strapless or have spaghetti straps.
- Safe/appropriate footwear must be worn at all times. The following footwear are preferred: heels, strappy sandals, dressy flats, dressy loafers, oxfords, lace-up shoes.

**Unacceptable Formal Dress:**

- Undergarments must not show.
- No midriff can show (even when arms are raised). Two piece dresses must overlap. Mesh/see through inserts in the midriff are not allowed. No cutouts.
- The back or side of the dress must not be too low-cut or revealing. The back of the dress should not go below the natural waist. Corsets must be laced closed or adhere to the open back rule. - Dress slits must not be higher than mid-thigh.
- No canes, ball caps, beanies or sweat bands are permitted.
- Shoes must be worn in the venue at all times - No flip flops or barefoot. **NO SNEAKERS or TENNIS SHOES.**
- No jeans, jeggings, or sweatpants.

**Students/Guests NOT IN COMPLIANCE with the Formal Dress Code policy listed above will not be admitted to the dance and will be sent home after their parents have been notified.**

Students and their guests are expected to follow **Salesian Dance Policy Guidelines** and behave in a manner fitting a Catholic School and a Formal Dance.

- Students must behave respectfully towards all staff and other students.
- Students and guests may have their bags, purses, and persons searched prior to entry into the dance.
- There is to be no inappropriate dancing or any sexually suggestive behavior.
- No violent mosh pitting.
- During the dance, the student host is 100% responsible for their guest's behavior and for making sure the guest is aware of all rules.
- **NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS ARE ALLOWED AT ANY TIME.** Please be aware that all students attending the dance may be randomly selected to take a breathalyzer test. If a student and/or their guest demonstrate the effects of alcohol or drugs at the dance, their parents will be notified and asked to pick them up.

***Failure to follow any of these guidelines is cause for immediate removal from the dance for both the host and guest. Both the parents and high school administrators of the host and guest will be notified, and participation in future activities will be jeopardized. In addition, no future guest passes will be issued to the host.***
