Dear Wyoming Families,

As we look ahead, the coming weeks bring several important milestones for our students, including End-of-Course (EOC) exams. These assessments represent both academic growth and an opportunity for students to demonstrate their learning and readiness.

EOC testing will begin on April 15th and continue through April 30th. These state-required, online exams are aligned to Ohio Department of Education standards and play an important role in meeting graduation requirements for students.

During testing days, we will follow modified delay schedules for students who are not testing. Only students scheduled to take an EOC exam on a given day should report at 7:50 a.m., as testing will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. All other students should plan to arrive according to the adjusted schedule listed below:

April 15–16 (English 10): [Students not testing - 2-hour delay, 1st period starts at 10:15 a.m.]

April 22–23 (Biology): [Students not testing - 90-minute delay, 1st period starts at 9:45 a.m.]

April 23 (U.S. History): [Students not testing - 90-minute delay, 1st period starts at 9:45 a.m.]

April 28–29 (Algebra I & Geometry): [Students not testing - 2-hour delay, 1st period starts at 10:15 a.m.]

April 30 (Make-up testing): regular 1st period start time at 8:00 a.m. for all students

Students taking an EOC exam should arrive on time and be prepared each day. This includes bringing their school-issued Chromebook fully charged, as devices and chargers will not be provided. Cell phones and other electronic devices are not permitted in the testing environment, so students should plan accordingly and store personal items in their lockers prior to testing.

We appreciate your continued partnership and support during this important time. EOC exams are a valuable opportunity for students to showcase their hard work and growth throughout the year. Encouraging a good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast can help set them up for success—we believe in their ability to do great things!
