A. Admin Report

- i. 258 enrollment, attendance is below 94% goal. Pledge is 136,200, percentage pledging 36%- still very low.
- ii. Next year's enrollment is moving forward. Meetings with all incoming families have happened.
- iii. 4th grade day trip, 5th grade trip. Middle school teachers working on middle school trips for next year
- iv. Calendar for district will be approved in upcoming district meeting
- v. 8th grade projects are happening next week

C. LCAP Review

- i. Must have stakeholder engagement and meet our goals in order to release our supplemental funding
- ii. We review dashboard and send out survey to school community

- iii. Reorganization of action for the LCAP. Will have one instead of 4 different ones. Many similarities across the district schools, starting in 26/27 year- start of new 3 year cycle
- iv. In Youth Truth survey students didn't feel other students were respectful of teachers- low score for us
- v. Will be doing Youth Truth survey for lower grades next year
- vi. Waldorf programs were combined under "student engagement"
- vii. There's an LCAP hub online
- viii. Requested feedback from Charter Council on areas of improvement and strengths:
  - 1. New furniture for middle school/ science room
  - 2. School counseling and social/emotional support is strong
  - 3. More support for math program- improve server
  - 4. Boy's bathroom very small
  - 5. Well outfitted for curriculum in terms of supplies
  - 6. Make middle school elective program more robust
  - 7. Grounds improvement needs
  - 8. Using instructional aids for student academic support
