Curriculum

Eau Claire High School offers a multi-level instructional program, which includes Dual Enrollment at Midlands Technical College, Advanced Placement Program (AP), Honors Program, College Preparation Program (College Prep), and Special Education courses. Students may qualify for academic college credit by enrolling in Dual Enrollment courses and passing the corresponding exams in the following areas: Advanced Placement Literature and Advanced Placement US History. Students with special needs and disabilities are placed in special education classes according to their disabilities. Additionally, we provide diagnostic and remedial services, as well as credit recovery (Edgenuity) to our students.

Honors and Awards

- Four Eau Claire High School students were recognized as Richland One Academic All-Stars. Our goal is to increase these numbers each year.
- A student represented Eau Claire High School as the Richland County Player of the Year.



- One student received the 2A Basketball Player of the Year.
- Eau Claire High School Student Council has been recognized as a 2026 National Council of Excellence
- Two Shamrocks were first place winners in the districts Secondary Annual STEM Showcase.
- Eau Claire Hosted the first ever Joint CTE Installation Ceremony.
- Coach Laurie is the 2A Basketball Coach of the year.
- One student won the 2026 Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dream Keeper Scholarships.

Student Assessments: 2024-2025

- Algebra I EOCE had a 56% passage rate
- English II EOCE had a 69% passage rate
- Biology I EOCE had a 27% passage rate
- US History EOCE had a 37% passage rate
- Graduation Rate **increased** from 79.9% to 84.1%
- 80.4% of Students were recognized for being College or Career Ready.

Other Notable Achievements

- Our bookkeeper was one of the recipients of the Diane Harlin Excellence in Bookkeeping Award.
- ECBS Dance Teacher was named South Carolina Dance Educator of the Year.



- Dr. Melanie Williams was awarded a \$500 grant from SC State Federal Credit Union to support an instructional project benefiting our students at Eau Claire High School.
- 9 Young men from ECBS were part of the R1 Male Mentoring Initiative Field Experience.
