

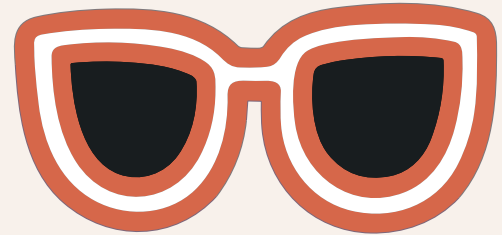

- Increased stress or uncertainty

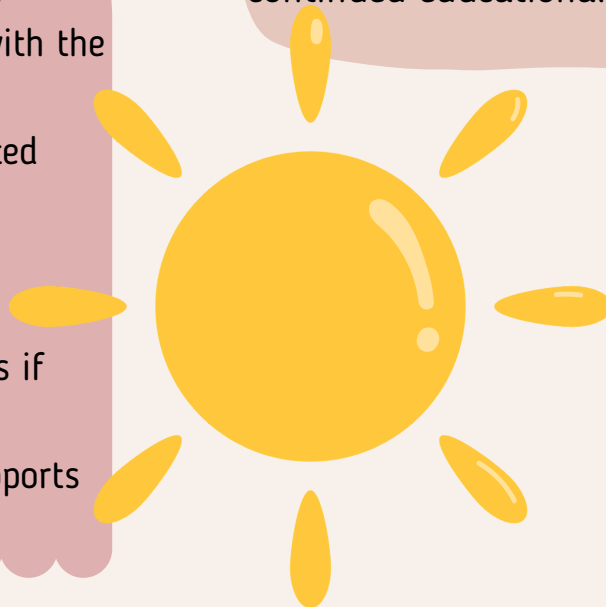
By communicating early, we can help connect families to resources and ensure continued educational stability
