## Graduation Ceremony Information

### Thursday, May 28, 2026 at 9:00 AM

### The Orleans Arena

#### Graduate and Family/Guest Information:

- Graduates must be holding (not wearing) their graduation gowns draped over their arm when they enter The Orleans; CCSD dress code will be enforced.
- No shorts, flip flops, slippers, or hand bags. Students violating the dress code will not be allowed to participate in the ceremony.
- Students may decorate their caps, but the decorations must be appropriate and flush (flat). They may not exceed the dimension of the cap.
- Only school-issued cords and medals are allowed, and cultural or religious adornments. Adornments must not cover more than 25 percent of the school selected graduation gown. This requirement applies to stoles, cords, medals, pins, and similar items.
- Students MUST arrive 1 hour (8:00 AM) prior to the ceremony.
- Graduates will go through security prior to checking in and lining up.
- Doors open for families/guests at 8:00 AM.
- Please do not bring noisemakers, air horns, or other devices that will disrupt the ceremony and prevent others from hearing the name of the next graduate.
- Only one clear bag per guest not larger than 12"X12"X6" or one small clutch no larger than 5"X9X2" allowed into the Arena.

#### Statement of Occasion

It is the philosophy of the Clark County School District and Silverado High School that high school graduation ceremonies are designed to honor graduates with a commencement ceremony that is solemn and dignified. The members of the Class of 2026 respectfully request that parents, family members, and other guests refrain from unnecessary noise and disruptions during the ceremony. It is the desire of the class of 2026 that graduates be honored equally and that all family and friends have the opportunity to hear their students be recognized. With this goal in mind, we ask for your cooperation in maintaining order during the ceremony, especially during the presentation of diplomas.

#### Tickets, Caps, Gowns, and Cords

Each student will receive twelve (12) guest tickets, along with their caps and gowns at the rehearsal. Students may give unused tickets to other students. Club cords will be distributed by the advisor. Honors cords will be distributed at Senior Awards Night. Students who miss Senior Awards Night should see their counselors for their Honors cords after Senior Awards Night.

#### Graduation Rehearsal

Graduation rehearsal will be held at Silverado High School on May 18, 2026 at 7:00 AM in the gymnasium (students only). This is a required event for graduation. Students unable to participate due to an excused absence (e.g. illness, college appointment, etc.) may pick up their graduation items on May 19 through May 21 from the Curriculum Office.

#### Grad Walk at Silverado

Grad Walk will begin around 9:00 AM on Monday, May 18, 2026. Families are welcome and encouraged to observe and take pictures as graduating seniors walk around campus in their cap and gown and are celebrated by students and staff.

## Additional Graduation Information

### Parking

Free parking is available at The Orleans. Students may be dropped off at the back entrance "Drop Off" to The Orleans prior to parking. Please see map to the left to review.

### General Seating

All guests must present a ticket to be admitted into the arena. General seating is open (not assigned). Strollers are not allowed.

### Seating – Mobility Limitations

Guests with mobility limitations will enter the arena using the B Gate entrance. One guest can be seated with each guest with limited mobility.

### Live Streaming

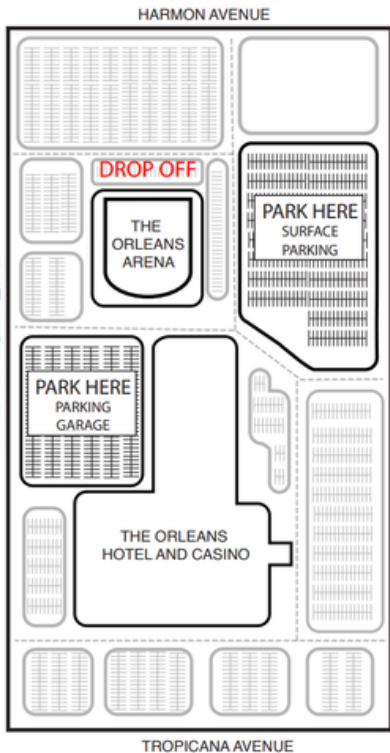
