### Y11 SUMMIT Sessions

As we approach the final few weeks before the exams, we wanted to communicate with you what we are doing to support your child with the preparation for their GCSEs.

We have relaunched the SUMMIT (after school sessions) on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday after school. The timetable is below:

This timetable will be running until the GCSEs start; then we will be amending it so that students can, where possible, attend specific revision sessions the afternoon before their exam.

In addition, we are running 'Lunchtime Lectures'. These are:

- Maths 7+ - Tuesday lunchtimes in Mr Richmond's room
- Maths Foundation paper – Wednesday lunchtimes in the Hall with Mrs Young
- English 7+ - Friday lunchtimes in Mrs Kirwan's room

If students wish to attend these, they should see Mr Richmond, Ms Young or Mrs Kirwan for a lunchtime queue jump pass.

We have two incentives running for attending a revision session:

- Snacks available at each session
- Each attended session (or past paper completed) gains a star on students' 'Summit Star Card'. A completed card gets students into a prize draw at the end of this half term to win prizes such as Amazon vouchers, chocolate (or a healthy alternative!) and other prizes.

We strongly encourage students to attend revision sessions, so that they are revising alongside their teacher and peers. This can often be much more effective than revising at home alone.

In the next couple of weeks, we will be sending out information about the expectations around the exams, study leave information and end of term celebrations.
