1. Call to Order

- Meeting called to order by G. Moyer at 6:00pm.
- Members present: G. Moyer, A. Daubert, K. Pribilla, D. Lukasewicz
- Admin Present: H. Renninger, S. Ziegmont, M. Janicelli
- Public Present: R. Hughes

2. School Code

- Changes from Act 47 of 2025
- Review of handout of changes that will affect PGA
 - S. Ziegmont provided an overview of Curriculum related Act 47 changes
 - No questions posed to S. Ziegmont or G. Moyer

3. TSI Designation

- Students with disabilities – graduation rate, attendance rate, and achievement
- Attending PDE TSI Sessions to gather information
- Plan due date June 30, 2026 – implementation for the 2026-2027 school year
 - S. Ziegmont & G. Moyer provided an overview of the HS Spec Ed TSI designation.
 - M. Janicelli further supported the overview with a deeper dive into what Spec Ed actually contains based on subgroups of students meeting the 20-count in a grade level as well as how PGA calculates absenteeism.
 - G. Moyer spoke on the class being discussed is actually the 23-24 8th grade class which was a COVID class. G. Moyer shared concerns about the overall mental health of these students.
 - No questions posed to S. Ziegmont, M. Janicelli, or G. Moyer

4. Elementary School Update

- Revamping schedules
- 4th grade math homogenous groupings
- Pre-K Counts enrollment application is open
 - S. Ziegmont and G. Moyer spoke about the Elementary School and how the admin is planning to revamp schedules and seriously explore groupings in 4th grade math.
 - K. Pribilla questioned if the Elementary is considering grouping grade 4 for Reading. S. Ziegmont explained that hasn't been discussed at this point but that she would talk with the elementary principal. K. Pribilla encouraged the admin to continue to explore that change.
 - No further questions posed.

5. Middle School Update

- There are no updates
 - D. Lukasewicz questioned the use of leveled readers at the MS and that he is hearing students are not being challenged. S. Ziegmont determined that he is referring to IXL and that students' effort and progress actually predetermine their assignments. D. Lukasewicz was very satisfied with that answer.
 - D. Lukasewicz also shared a concern about the over usage of technology in a math class. S. Ziegmont assured him that data is showing progress from that class and that she would continue to monitor.

6. Course Selection Booklet Review (High School)

- Review of course selections
- Review of current implementation from changes made last year
- Graduation requirements review
 - M. Janicelli & G. Moyer highlighted all changes in the proposed 2026-2027 HS Course Selection booklet.
 - M. Janicelli reviewed how scheduling is completed at the HS from start to finish. This explanation provided some clarity concerns board members were having about the stacking of classes and student numbers associated with these classes.
 - M. Janicelli & G. Moyer explained about how we are still in the transition phase of the district graduation requirement change.

7. Cooperative Education Update (High School)

- Review of the Implementation Plan - Vision
- Discussion of Implementation Plan
 - S. Ziegmont, G. Moyer, & M. Janicelli introduce Cooperative Education
 - PDE guidelines were presented and handed out to attendees
 - S. Ziegmont presented an implementation plan for Cooperative Education and provided a document for all present. S. Ziegmont reviewed year one in detail
 - All members present are excited about this program and greatly look forward to its implementation.

8. New Business - anything for us to move forward on regarding curriculum

- S. Ziegmont, M. Janicelli, & G. Moyer discussed the state of the current HS Library and the need for it to be revamped.
- The discussion focused on the creation of a Career Center to support the Cooperative Education program.
- M. Janicelli showed a visual of the current library. The members in attendance appeared excited about the idea and gave full go ahead to begin the process of removing items and making a changeover to a Career center environment. G. Moyer will update the full board at the next meeting.
