Mail Order - 90 Day Supply Deductible then; Tier 1: \$20 copay Tier 2: \$50 copay Tier 3: \$135 copay

HOW THE DEDUCTIBLE & PRESCRIPTION PORTIONS OF YOUR BCBS ACCESS BLUE NE SAVER II PLAN WORK

◆ **You and/or your family visit a provider (doctor, hospital, ER, etc.)**

- Show your BCBS ID Card to the provider

◆ **Provider:**

- Bills BCBS

◆ **BCBS:**

- Adjudicates claim
- Sends a Summary of Health Plan Payments to you and your provider. The Summary is not a bill and should be saved for your records!

◆ **You:**

- Receive your BCBS EOB and adjusted provider bill. Once they match use your RSI debit card for payment
- You are responsible to pay your portion of the deductible to your provider once your debit card is exhausted
- Prescription Drugs are paid for at time of service using your RSI debit card. Once the debit card allotment is exhausted, you will pay the remaining portion of your deductible and the respective Rx copay
