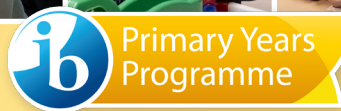


DOES YOUR 4-YEAR-OLD HALF-DAY STUDENT NEED BUS TRANSPORTATION?

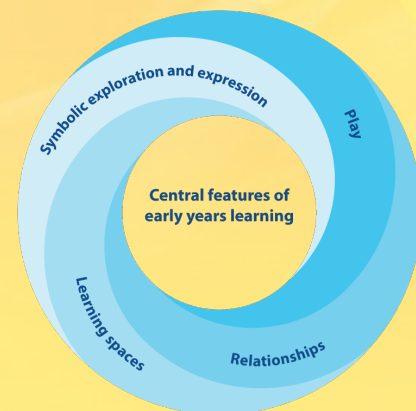
High-quality and Aligned Curriculum
