- Enthusiasm for the content area that is contagious in the classroom and supportive of student growth and confidence and is always in keeping with school mission, goals and values.
- Learning and utilizing the school's learning management and student information systems for accurate and complete record-keeping, grading, and reporting for all student activities, achievement, and attendance as required.
