



Kindergarten Early Entry Application Process

Submission of Application

Parents who wish to apply for early kindergarten admission for their child must complete the online registration application available at www.cbsd.org/register. In addition to the registration form, a formal written request letter specifically requesting early entry to kindergarten is required. This letter should be uploaded within the application, under the section for report card upload (please see below for a visual).

Review of Application

Once the application and supporting documentation are submitted, the school's core team will undertake a comprehensive review. This team is comprised of the principal, assistant principal, school counselor, and school psychologist. Together, they will evaluate the submitted information and initiate the Early Kindergarten Entry evaluative process.

Assessment Timing

The Central Bucks School District will contact parents by April 15 to schedule the necessary assessments. These assessments will take place during May and June, with all evaluations finalized by June 18, 2026.

Early Kindergarten Entry Evaluative Process

As part of the evaluative process, the school counselor will arrange a session involving both the family and the child. During this session, a school readiness assessment will be conducted. This assessment is designed to measure the child's preparedness for kindergarten by evaluating the following areas:

- Letters
- Numbers and Counting
- Shapes
- Self and Social Awareness

Additionally, if applicable, the school psychologist may perform an observation of the child in their current preschool setting.

Decision and Conclusion

All requests must be made by Friday, April 17, 2026, as time is needed to schedule screenings.

After gathering and thoroughly reviewing all pertinent information and assessment data, the school team will make a recommendation regarding early entry to kindergarten. Parents will receive this recommendation by June 30, 2026.
