SCHOLARSHIP TIPS

It's April and college decisions along with awards letters should be in your inboxes. You are having to make decisions about where you will attend in the fall. One main component is deciding whether a college is the right fit, both academically and financially. You may be wondering if there are still scholarships that you can win. The answer is yes! So, continue applying for scholarships even through the summer. Take time to apply for smaller scholarships because the applicant pool is likely to be smaller. Proofread essays to ensure the topics match the criteria and gather all essential documents (transcript, SAI report, recommendations, and your resume into a Google folder for easy access.

In a recently post on social media, a parent asked if they should have their child complete the FAFSA, even though their child would not qualify for any financial aid. The answer is YES! Some scholarships require the Student Aid Index report or the SAI score as a requirement for the applications. The only way for organizations to know your SAI is if students fill out the FAFSA. The SAI establishes demonstrated need. Although your student's score may be high, it doesn't mean that you can pay the SAI that Student Aid has given. Be sure to complete the FAFSA by the college's deadline.
