Parent Teacher Association (PTA) Meeting Minutes
Tuesday, April 14th, 2026

Treasurer's Report: No funds have been in or out but after communication with the lawyer about the 501c3 we will continue purchases out of the Bravera bank account for this year. Kerry gave us information about checks deposited to start our Foundation account. These were check from the Silent Auction found in the safe. The money is currently sitting in a shared PR account until all parts are completed by PTA to open the new Foundation account. The amount of \$615.83 will be deposited once all paperwork is completed and provided.

Principal's Report: Money donated for the library from Duane's Auto body is being spent on a new L-shaped bench and an addition to the library desk. Book displays, rugs and a wireless book scanner will also be purchased.

Staff will be shifting: Mr. Gable will be transferring to Miller Elementary. Ms. Hansen will continue to teach 4th grade next year at Prairie Rose. Mr. Stoltz did not renew his contract and will be staying home with their families' new addition. Sammy Minor will be working through CampEd but will not be returning as secretary next year. Kerry will be moving to Elk Ridge and join their 4th grade team. At this point we will be 1 section in each grade level. There should be 2 sections of CampEd at Prairie Rose.

Dr. Fastnacht will be at PR April 30th to present about the bond issue and the effects it will have on our school. Our school will have an open house from 5:00-6 pm and then he will lead a presentation about the bond issue.

Old/Current Business:

- Bingo for Books -
 - Overall it went over well
 - There were a lot of books
 - Can we pair with another school who may not have the opportunity to have this type of event and donate books to them for an event?
 - The success in donations brought up thoughts about possible donations for Christmas or some sort of toy swap instead of the Dollar Store - would definite need to put parameters around
 - Think about the amount of time we schedule the event and possible switch the movie and book night
 - Pizza purchases from Sams - 12 were ordered - consistently we have had too much pizza so consider ordering less unless we move to a cooler month
 - Purchased 1 case of water, 1 box of Rice Krispie Bars, 2 boxes of chips
 - Soda we sold extra we had from other events

- Bylaws
 - 501c3 cannot move forward without the Bylaws
 - We reviewed all changes made to the Bylaw by the PTA officers. Another adjustment was made in verbiage about when new officers will take their positions
 - Heather motioned to approve the new Bylaws
 - Kerry 2nd
 - All approved - none opposed

 - If we could get donations of digital cameras and have students start helping with the pictures
 - For events try to get volunteers like room parents who come to event take pictures to send in
 - 68 bought and paid for
 - Any extras we would have to pay for
 - Send out a message we have less than 10 less so contact Sammy to purchase for \$20
 - Heather proposed we donate a yearbook to the library
 - Hannah 2nd
 - All approved - none opposed
 - We approved for Heather to put in a commitment for next year
 - Edit - commitment was put in for next year and due to our early commitment, we will get a discount and the option for either 5 free yearbooks or 2 yard signs for next year
