

STUDENT CAMPUS DRIVING AND PARKING REGULATIONS

JUNIORS 2025-2026

Student use of motor vehicles at Northwestern is a privilege granted by the school. Students are subject to the rules, regulations and administrative guidelines in this parking regulations agreement and must comply with all laws and licensure requirements.

Student parking permits are \$60.00 for the year. (replacement decals will cost \$5.00 per vehicle.) Checks should be made payable to RSD#7. This is the fee assigned for parking privileges by the Board of Education. A portion of these funds is used to support student activities and interests. The parking permit must be displayed on the front windshield, driver's side, bottom corner. Students must abide by the following regulations:

- Student drivers must comply with Connecticut's Graduated Driver Licensing laws including the nighttime curfew restrictions, passenger restrictions, and all drivers and passengers must wear a seat belt. Any violations of these regulations could result in the immediate seizure of student's driver's license. The student driver will be subject to any other consequences by law.
- Adhere to the posted speed limit on school grounds of **15 mph** and come to a complete stop at all stop signs.
- Do not pass a standing school bus with red flashing stop lights and do not enter a line of school buses or attempt to pass a moving school bus.
- Park in the designated space and display the parking permit on the car's window.
- In the event that a student's car is involved in a crash on school property, report immediately to House 1 and our School Resource Officer .
- A student who uses his/her vehicle to leave school grounds without permission, or who exhibits a pattern of tardiness to school may lose this privilege.
- Your driving privilege and decal may not be sold, given, or loaned to another student. Students may share a spot with administration approval once proper paperwork is on file.
- **The administration has the right to search a student's vehicle on school grounds if there is probable cause that a student may be in possession of contraband, including but not limited to drugs, weapons and alcohol.**
- **Parking in spaces not assigned to you will result in fines. \$5 for first offense, \$10 for second offense, 5 day driving privilege suspension for 3rd offense.**
- **Driving prior to receiving permission to have a vehicle on school property will affect your ability to obtain a parking permit.**

Violation of any parking/driving regulations will have consequences. Penalties may include detention, suspension, fine and towing. Continued violations could result in temporary or permanent revocation of permitted privileges.

In order to be fair, a lottery system is used for student parking.

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A **MANDATORY** meeting is scheduled for Monday, September 8, 2025, 7:00 a.m. in the Little Theater. *Your student should be there if they plan on driving during their Junior year.*

All class dues, **including Junior dues**, must be paid prior to receiving a parking sticker. Cash or a **separate check** may be made out to RSD7, note "2027 class dues" in the memo. (Class dues are \$25.00 for each school year.)

- Juniors who are eligible to drive must have their Campus Parking Form & all required documents listed below mailed back to Mrs. Vacila, House 1 Secretary no later than **August 25, 2025.**

(Payment for parking is accepted when picking up your parking sticker.) Incomplete forms will not be entered into the lottery. Please check expiration dates on driver's license, DMV registration and insurance cards. Be sure you and your parent/guardian have signed this form.

- Juniors will pay for their parking privilege and pick up their parking permit on Monday, September 8 after the meeting or during their **commons** period during the third week of school. **YOU CANNOT DRIVE TO SCHOOL UNTIL YOU OBTAIN YOUR PARKING PERMIT!**
