As enrollment grows and student needs evolve, our facilities must support high-quality teaching, learning, and student services. We are gathering input to understand how our spaces can best support students now and in the future.

### Enrollment & Growth

#### Recent Growth

- Enrollment has increased by over 300 students in recent years
- Growth includes more students needing specialized supports:
  - English learners, students with disabilities

#### Current Space Challenges

- Many buildings are operating beyond their intended capacity.
- Non-traditional spaces (conference rooms, offices, shared areas)

#### What this Means

- Less space for staff collaboration
- Limited flexibility for future growth
- Scheduling and program challenges

### Looking Ahead

#### Projected Growth

- Moderate growth: **160+ students**
- Higher growth: **430+ students**

#### Facility Needs

- Additional classroom and small group spaces
- Dedicated program space (Preschool, WORLD, ARC)
- Staff professional learning areas
- Improvements to athletic facilities
- Ongoing maintenance and upgrades

#### Key Consideration

- C. Ray is the oldest building in WCS*
- Cost of improvements is significant
- Options include renovation or rebuilding
