Dear Wyoming Families,

As we continue progressing through a busy and exciting stretch of the school year at Wyoming High School, there is much to celebrate and anticipate. This week kicked off the beginning of End-of-Course (EOC) testing with ELA II, providing students an opportunity to showcase their learning. On testing days, we will continue following adjusted schedules to support a focused environment. Students scheduled to test should arrive by 7:50 a.m. Exams start promptly at 8:00 a.m. Additional details can be found in this [WHS - Spring 2026 EOC Letter to Families](#). Non-testers will follow these start times:

April 22–23 (Biology): 90-minute delay, classes begin at 9:45 a.m.

April 23 (U.S. History): 90-minute delay, classes begin at 9:45 a.m.

April 28–29 (Algebra I & Geometry): 2-hour delay, classes begin at 10:15 a.m.

April 30 (Make-up testing): Regular start time of 8:00 a.m. for all students

Reminder, students taking exams should come prepared with a fully charged school-issued Chromebook, as devices and chargers will not be available. **As a reminder, cell phones, smart watches, and other electronics are not permitted in testing rooms and should be secured in lockers beforehand.**

Outside the classroom, excitement is building for Prom this Saturday, a highlight of the school year for many students. Best of luck to our Science Olympiad Team at State this weekend! All the meanwhile, AP exams are approaching, and students are continuing to put in strong effort as they prepare.

A note for SENIORS: tuxedo measurements for graduation will take place on Thursday, April 23rd.
