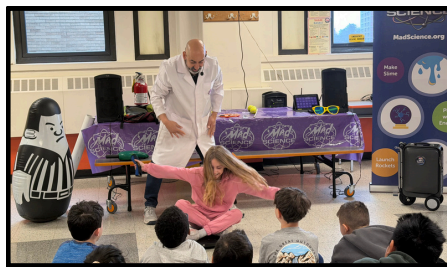

### Mad Science with Grades 3 & 4 in the Spotlight!

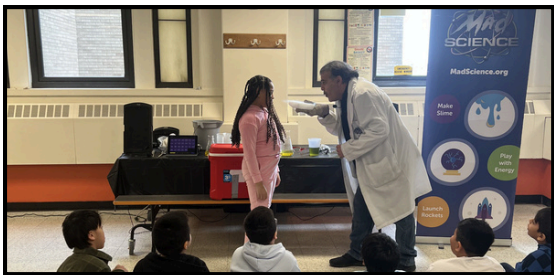
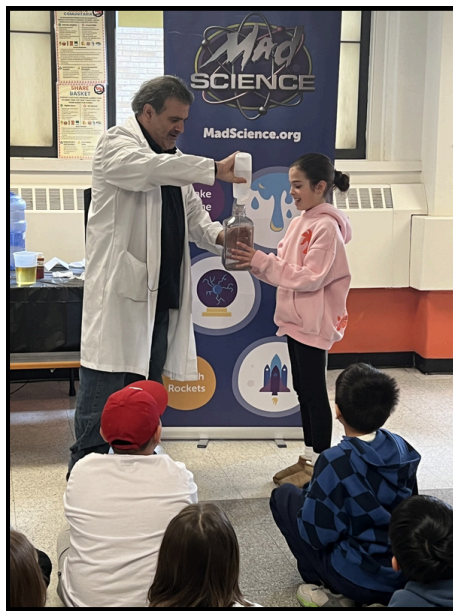

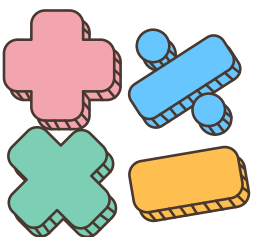
