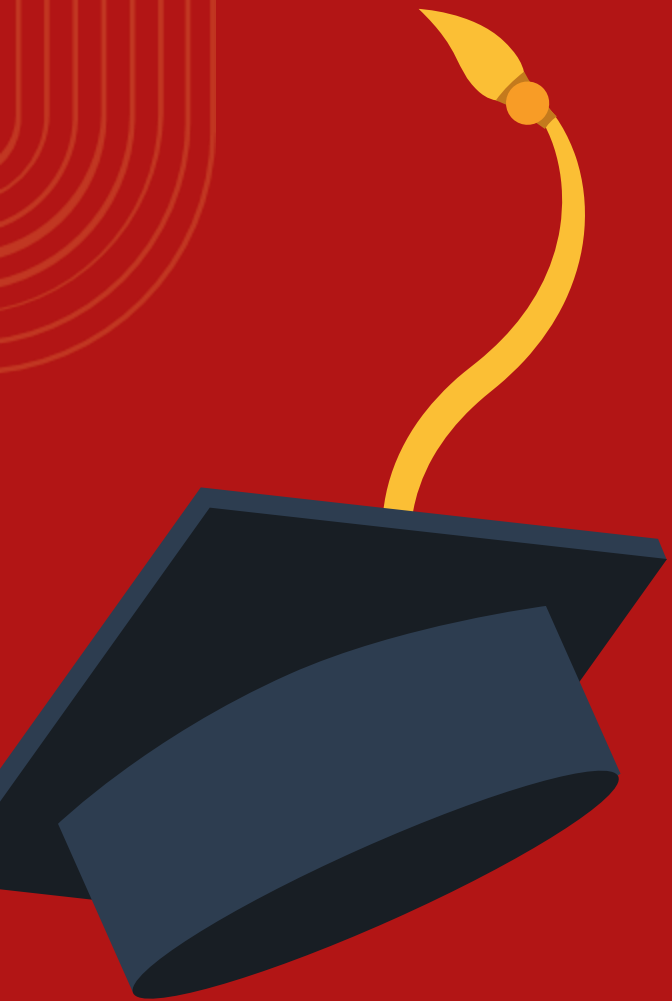

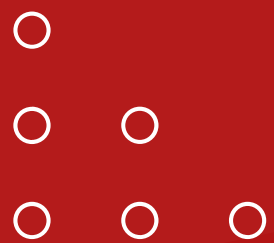

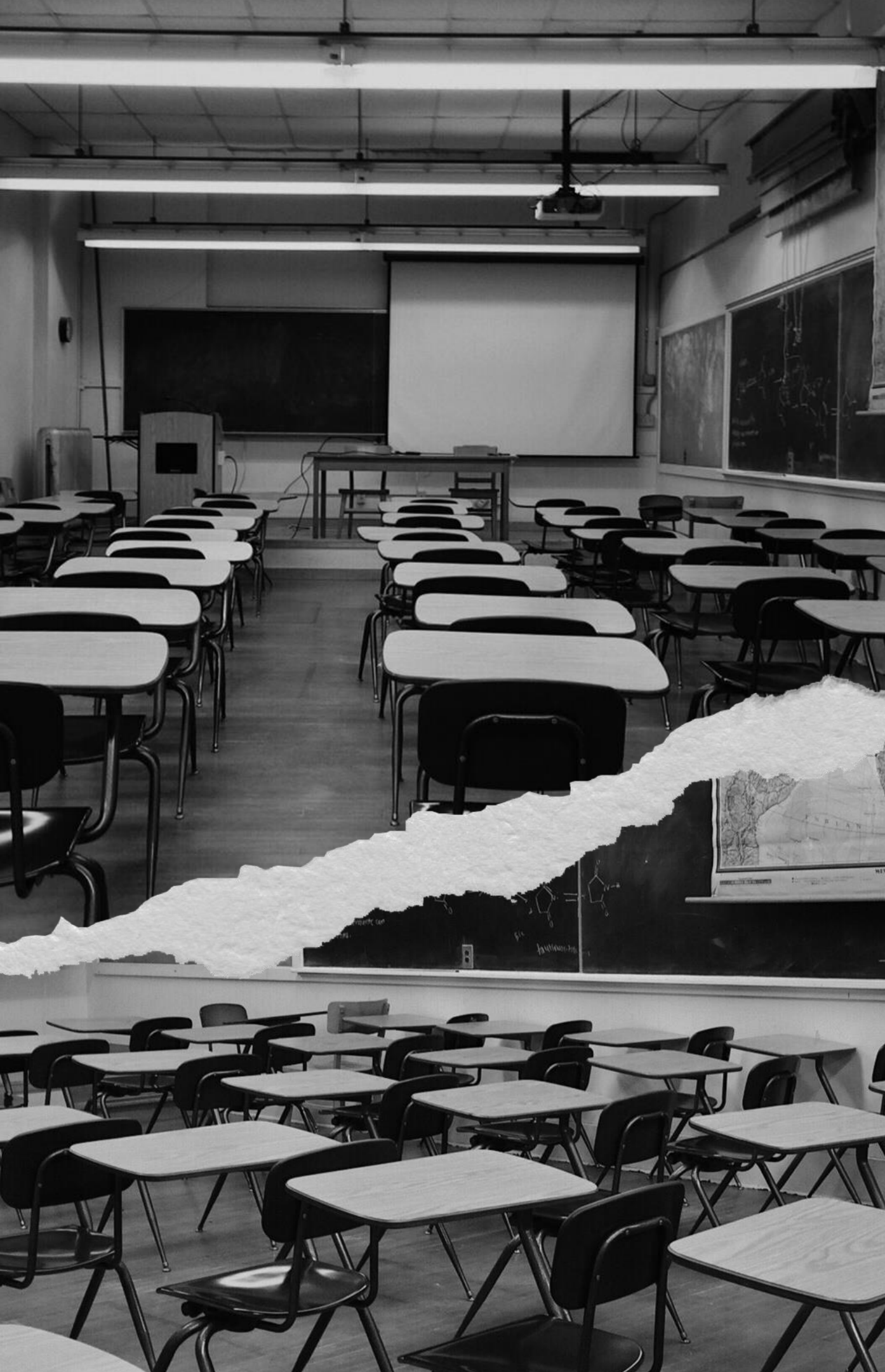


# CAP & GOWN - 4/17



- *You will be able to pick-up your pre-purchased or borrowed cap/gown.*
- *If you still need to purchase a cap/gown they will be on sale in the Pavilion for \$40 cash only, with limited sizes available.*
- *Caps/gowns will also be available to borrow free of charge at the Student Store on Friday, April 17, after 2:30pm. (First come, first serve basis. )*
- *Borrowed cap/gown must be returned when picking up your diploma starting on Monday, June 8, from 9:00 am-12:00 pm, in the THS front office.*

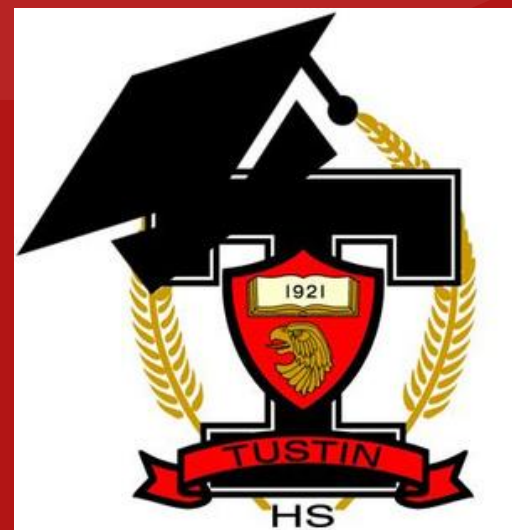

- *THE GRADUATION CEREMONY STARTS PROMPTLY AT 6:00 PM. ON TUESDAY, MAY 26.*

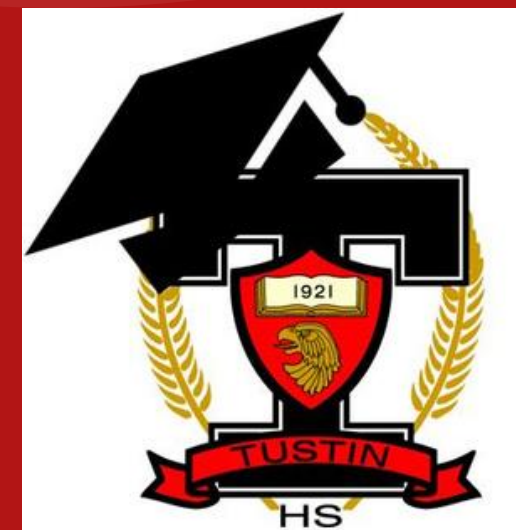


# **PARKING AND SEATING INFORMATION**

***WHERE SHOULD FAMILY MEMBERS AND GUESTS  
PARK AND SIT IN THE STADIUM?***

- ***THIS WILL DEPEND ON WHERE YOU AS A GRADUATE ARE SITTING ON THE FIELD, WHICH WILL BE EITHER THE “BLACK SIDE” OR “RED SIDE.” (YOU WILL KNOW WHAT SIDE YOU ARE SITTING ON AT GRADUATION PRACTICE ON THURSDAY, MAY 21.)***
- ***REMEMBER, MAKE SURE TO TELL YOUR FAMILY MEMBERS AND GUESTS WHAT SIDE OF THE STADIUM TO SIT ON SO THEY CAN HAVE THE BEST VIEW OF YOU ON THE FIELD.***

# ***“BLACK SIDE” SEATING & PARKING INFO***

- ***IF YOU AS A GRADUATE ARE SEATED ON THE “BLACK SIDE,” PARKING WILL BE ON THE FIELD BEHIND THE VISITORS BLEACHERS OFF SAN JUAN STREET.***
- ***GUESTS WILL BE ABLE TO ENTER THE STADIUM ON THE “BLACK SIDE,” (VISITOR BLEACHERS).***
- ***“BLACK SIDE” GRADUATES WILL EXIT THE FIELD AREA BEHIND THE VISITOR BLEACHERS AFTER THE CEREMONY TO MEET UP WITH FAMILY MEMBERS AND GUESTS.***

# ***“RED SIDE” SEATING & PARKING INFO***

- ***IF YOU AS A GRADUATE ARE SEATED ON THE “RED SIDE”, PARKING WILL BE IN THE MAIN PARKING LOT AT THS. (YOU WILL KNOW WHAT SIDE YOU ARE SITTING ON AT GRADUATION PRACTICE ON THURSDAY, MAY 21).***
- ***Guests will be able to enter the stadium at the main entrance between the Pavilion and pool area.***
- ***Please note that once the lot is full, you will be directed to the parking area off of San Juan Street.***
- ***“RED SIDE” graduates will exit the field out to the main parking lot after the ceremony to meet up with family members and guests.***

# GRADUATE ARRIVAL TO GRADUATION

- *ALL GRADUATES ARE TO REPORT TO THE PAVILION ON TUESDAY, MAY 26 AT 4:45 PM CARRYING YOUR CAP & GOWN.*
- *ALL graduates will be breathalyzed, and the dress code will be enforced.*
- *Graduates who are not appropriately dressed will be removed from the ceremony.*
- *No graduates will be allowed into the ceremony if you arrive late. If there is one time in your life that you are on time for an event, this is it!*
- *CHECK-IN time is at 4:45 PM at the Pavilion on 5/26.*

# APPROPRIATE DRESS CODE FOR THE GRADUATE

Please Dress in a “Business Casual” Manner

- *WHEN ARRIVING FOR CHECK-IN, HAVE CAP AND GOWN IN HAND. YOU MAY WANT TO BRING BOBBY PINS TO SECURE YOUR CAP.*
- *Dress slacks, dress shirt (tie optional), blouses, skirts/dresses*
- *Comfortable dress shoes-Flats only! because of the amount of walking,standing, and to prevent damage to the synthetic track and field.*

# NOT PERMITTED

- ***NO DEFACING OR ALTERING YOUR CAP AND GOWN IN ANY WAY OR FORM!***
- ***No flip-flops or beach sandals, Vans, converse, gym shoes, slippers***
- ***No heels of any kind including -high/spiked/wedge heels because of the amount of walking, standing, and to prevent damage to the synthetic track and field. You may wear these types of shoes at the Reflections ceremony only.***
- ***No jeans, shorts, pajamas, yoga/sweatpants***

# ITEMS NOT PERMITTED

- ***NO BACKPACKS, PURSES, BAGS***
- ***No sunglasses***
- ***No food or drink***
- ***Graduates not dressed appropriately will not be admitted into the ceremony.***

# DIPLOMAS

- *AT THE GRADUATION CEREMONY, STUDENTS WILL ONLY RECEIVE A DIPLOMA COVER.*
- *DIPLOMAS ARE NOT PASSED OUT AT THE ACTUAL CEREMONY.*
- *DIPLOMA PICK UP WILL TAKE PLACE AT TUSTIN HIGH STARTING ON MONDAY, JUNE 8 FROM 9:00AM-12:00PM.*
- *FOR STUDENTS WHO BORROWED A CAP OR GOWN, THEY MUST RETURN THESE ITEMS WHEN PICKING UP THEIR DIPLOMA.*

# GRAD NITE AT UNIVERSAL HOLLYWOOD

- ***WHAT: THIS IS A SAFE, SOBER, DRUG AND ALCOHOL FREE CELEBRATION FOR SENIORS***
- ***Where: Universal studios Hollywood***
- ***When: Thursday, May 21***
- ***All graduates must check in at the Tustin High School Sports Pavilion starting at 1:00 pm-2:15 pm. The last bus will depart THS for Universal at 2:30pm. All students who attend Grad Nite MUST ride the bus to and from the event. We will arrive at Universal around 4:00 pm where tickets will be distributed.***

# GRAD NITE AT UNIVERSAL HOLLYWOOD

## *COST:*

- *\$170 FEBRUARY 1- FEBRUARY 28*
- *\$180 MARCH 1-APRIL 4*
- *PERMISSION SLIPS AT THE STUDENT STORE*
- *No refunds will be given.*

*\* Bring extra money if you want to buy extra food or beverages. See permission slip for more details.*

# GRAD NITE AT UNIVERSAL HOLLYWOOD

- ***BUSES WILL DEPART UNIVERSAL AT 2:30 AM TO RETURN TO THS. THE EXPECTED ARRIVAL BACK AT THS IS AROUND 3:30 AM. UPON RETURN, STUDENTS WITH A RIDE MAY LEAVE TO GO HOME (THIS INCLUDES PARENTS PICKING KIDS UP AS WELL AS STUDENTS SELF-DRIVING HOME FROM THS). PERMISSION SLIPS MUST REFLECT THIS. IF STUDENTS DO NOT HAVE A RIDE HOME, WE WILL HAVE THE PAVILION OPEN FOR DONUTS AND A MOVIE. ALL STUDENTS WILL THEN BE RELEASED AT 5:30 AM.***

# GRAD NITE AT UNIVERSAL HOLLYWOOD

## Dress Code

All students **MUST** adhere to the Dress code or entrance to grad nite may not be permitted. Remember, it gets very cold at night. Acceptable examples of dress code include:

- *COLLARED SHIRT (POLO, BUTTON UP, FLANNEL STYLE SHIRTS ARE OK), T-SHIRTS, BLOUSE, SWEATER*
- *Jeans, leggings, yoga pants*
- *Comfortable shoes - tennis shoes (would not suggest flip flops or sandals)*
- *Purses and drawstring backpacks (no larger than 8.5" x 11")*
- *Layer clothing*
- *jackets/sweatshirts/sweaters.*
- ***Universal is STRICT about dress code and WILL NOT let you in if you violate it.***

# GRAD NITE AT UNIVERSAL HOLLYWOOD

## Not Permitted:

- ***NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES***
- ***No backpacks or any large or overstuffed duffle bags***
- ***No extremely revealing clothing. No skin showing in the mid-section/stomach/side/back.***
- ***No headwear of any kind (hats, bandanas, or beanies)***
- ***No clothing displaying profanity, pornography, violence, support of drugs and drug use, gang symbols & promotion of discrimination against any group***
- ***\*\*Six flags security may deny admission if clothing or tattoos are deemed inappropriate.***
