PROFESSIONAL FACULTY

Each class at VSA Summer Fest will be staffed with a homeroom teacher, a main instructor, and an assistant instructor.

The homeroom teachers are from Victoria Kindergarten and VSA, possessing rich experience in classroom management and professional educational backgrounds. The VSA school nurse will be on standby, promptly handling any unexpected situations and safeguarding the health of the children.

The course instructors come from VSA and professional institutions that have long-term collaborations with VSA and possess extensive teaching experience in their respective fields, allowing children to master new skills in an immersive bilingual classroom.

COURSE DETAILS

The VSA Summer Fest integrates VSA teachers and Hong Kong's leading course teams and renowned lecturers from various fields, bringing together top-notch educational resources within the 5-day course. Here are introductions to some of the courses and lecturers:



STEAM | for all age groups

Break through subject boundaries and integrate Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, and Mathematics into one. The STEAM sparks children's interest in science and enhances their problem-solving abilities through hands-on activities in physics, biology, earth science, and other fields. Children will explore a wide range of daily knowledge, uncover the mysteries of natural phenomena, and understand themselves and their relationship with the world. They will learn to operate scientific equipment, develop scientific thinking, and improve scientific literacy and spirit.

Creative Arts | for all age groups

This innovative arts curriculum is designed to cultivate children's flexibility and adaptive skills while fostering their creative development. Instructors will introduce students to iconic works by master artists, guiding them to explore these creators' unique perspectives and techniques. Inspired by paintings, sculptures, designs, and illustrations across art history, young artists will ignite their own creativity through a process that values playful expression and honors each child's spontaneous originality. 8-11-year-old will experience traditional handmade arts such as rubbing, printmaking, and sculpture.

COURSE DETAILS



Folk Dance | for 3.5–4 years old

Designed to foster appreciation for China's rich dance heritage, our curriculum immerses students in ethnic traditions including Dai, Mongolian, Tibetan, and Uyghurs, transmitting cultural values while building artistic pride. The teacher will lead the children to appreciate the ethnic customs. In the classroom, the children will wear exquisite ethnic costumes and learn Chinese ethnic dance moves with joy and fun.

Ballroom Dance | 3.5–4, 5–7 years old

Breaking away from single-skill teaching methods, Ballroom Dance adopts a dynamic approach to create an exhilarating learning environment through music and dance. Here, children will not only acquire essential movement techniques and improve physical coordination, but also develop musical sensitivity and rhythm awareness. Multiple foreign teachers will use familiar English nursery rhymes and movie themes to string together the dance throughout the entire class, leading children to fully embrace the joy of moving their bodies!

COURSE DETAILS

Readventure | for 5-7, 8-11 years old



Readventure is an English Inquiry Reading Program that blends reading with creative hands-on activities to deepen comprehension through active expression. The 5-7-year-old classes explore picture books by creating character masks or story dioramas, boosting both language skills and creativity. The 8-11-year-old classes analyze book themes to design original projects, refining their work through peer feedback. This approach fosters independent learning, critical thinking, and problem-solving abilities while nurturing a lifelong love of reading.

Coding | for 5-7, 8-11 years old



Fun programming combined with creative thinking helps children become little tech makers! Using OctoStudio, children will learn basic programming commands, scoring systems, interactive mechanisms, app building, and more, designing their own mobile games and transforming from players into creators! By the end of the course, children will not only have an interactive digital project but also develop logical thinking and problem-solving skills. Ages 5-7 will design their own "Gold Rush Hero," and ages 8-11 will design a single-player racing game.

Outdoor Explorer | for 5-7, 8-11 years old



An exciting outdoor exploration journey combining physical challenges, nature discovery, and hands-on creation! Children will take on an obstacle course challenge (including climbing terrain and wading through knee-deep water) to build courage, resilience, and teamwork; learn basic woodworking design and construction to inspire creativity. Beach treasure hunt games develop observation and problem-solving skills. The program guides children to embrace challenges, get close to nature, and build confidence and environmental awareness through hands-on activities and adventures – making learning full of fun and excitement.

FAQ

Q1) Does the child participate in the summer camp independently?

The child participates in summer camp independently and needs to be picked up and dropped off by parents.

We welcome parents to attend the welcome registration on Monday or Sunday

Q2) What is the teaching language?

The main teaching languages are English and Mandarin.

Q3) Are meals and snacks provided?

Yes, a morning snack and lunch are provided, with the cost included in the camp fee.

Meals are catered by a professional school meal service, offering a balanced variety of meat and vegetable dishes that change daily over the week. Any dietary allergies will be accommodated based on the information provided.

Q4) Is school bus service available?

Yes. The school bus is for students only; parents may not ride along. Routes are as follows:

Tin Hau Station → Ocean Park Marriott Station → VSA

The Arca Station → Wong Chuk Hang Station → VSA

Q5) How do I drop off and pick up my child if I do not choose the school bus?

For self-driving, enter via the 2/F drop-off area (no parking). A car pass will be provided at registration.

For other transport (e.g., taxi, walking), please enter via the main entrance on G/F.

Q6) Can the same child sign up for multiple weeks?

Weekly camp structures are similar, but the content alternates every two weeks. Content A is covered in Weeks 1, 3, and 5; Content B in Weeks 2 and 4. We recommend registering for a maximum of two consecutive weeks.

Q7) Can non-Victorian children register?

Sure. VSA summer camp is open to Victoria students, graduates & friends to participate in.

Q8) Can I register my child to the older camp group?

For the better experience of your child, we suggest you select the age group based on their actual age at the time of participating in the camp.

Q9) What should my child bring to camp?

The school will provide two camp T-shirts, a backpack, and a campus ID card during registration.

Please prepare the following personal items:

- A water bottle (clearly labelled with your child's name)
- A light jacket or cardigan
- A spare mask
- On cooking days, please bring a food container

*For younger children, we recommend bringing a small towel and a change of clothes

*Teaching materials and stationery will be provided by the school.

Q10) What is the arrangement in case of severe weather?

The school will follow official guidelines issued by the Education Bureau. No refunds or make-up sessions will be offered in the event of class cancellations due to severe weather.

Q11) Will there be a performance on Friday?

Due to adjustments in the course plan, this year's summer camp will end at 3:00 PM as usual every Friday, with no group performance or dinner arranged.

*For the 3.5–4 year old class, parents may enter the classroom in batches between 14:10 and 15:00 to watch the presentation performance.

SCHEDULE

DAY 1 – Icebreaker and Warm-up

The camp kicks off with team-building activities, games, roleplay, and improvisation to help students bond and explore texts and scenes. They'll be introduced to the music and movements of the chosen musical, starting costume measurements as well.

DAY 2 – Initial Exploration

Students will dive into games, improvisation, and the themes of the musical. They'll continue learning songs, choreography, and exploring their unique talents to match roles, wrapping up with journal updates.

DAY 3~8 – Practice and Refinement

Mornings focus on vocal and dance training to build strong performers, while afternoons emphasize actor training and character development. Students will master songs, choreography, and transitions between singing, acting, and dancing to ensure a seamless performance.

WRITING CAMP

WRITING CAMP

VSA Writing Camp offers a fun and engaging writing experience for children aged 8–11. The program is led by a literacy expert from Teachers College, Columbia University, and spans two weeks around two core themes: Narrative Writing—turning life into stories; and Persuasive Writing—expressing ideas with clarity. Through interactive games, writing partnerships, and a "read like writers" approach, the instructor helps children learn to brainstorm, revise, and publish their work in a relaxed and supportive environment.

The camp is suitable for students from international schools in Mainland China as well as local students in Hong Kong; a good foundation in English is required.

Non-current VSA or VPA students are required to **submit proof of English proficiency:**

1. School English subject transcript or Lexile reading assessment score report
2. An English essay independently completed by the student
3. (Optional) Other official score reports provided by recognized English testing institutions

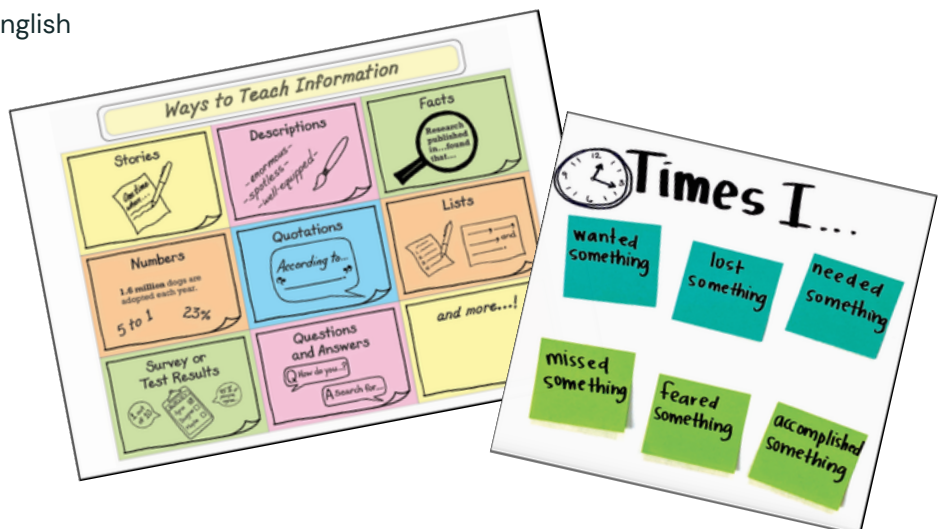

COURSE DETAILS



Week 1 | Narrative Writing

Bringing Stories and Student Voices to Life

Our interactive writing camp guides students through the writing process, using tools like identity maps, neighborhood maps, and "Times I..." to uncover meaningful stories from their own lives.

Across the week, students will:

- Plan and draft – using storyboarding and oral rehearsal
- Work with writing partners – sharing ideas and giving supportive feedback
- Revise – building tension, bringing characters to life, and using figurative language
- Edit – improving sentence structure and punctuation
- Publish and celebrate – writing an "About the Author" and contributing to a class anthology

By the end of the week, students will have a completed narrative piece, a deeper understanding of themselves as writers, and strategies to use in future writing.

In this persuasive writing camp, students will learn to express opinions and persuade others with clear reasoning and strong evidence.

Across the week, students will:

- Practice taking a stand with simple "this or that" arguments

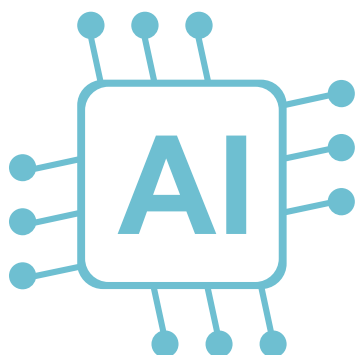
