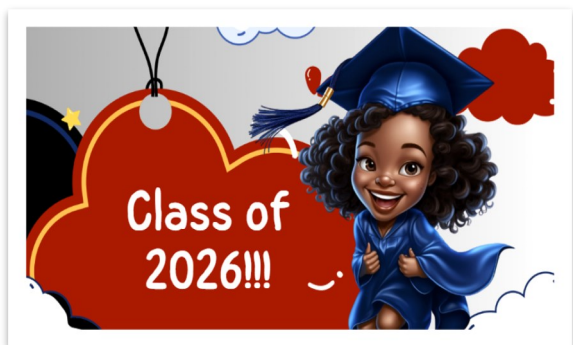
SPRING 2026

CHS SENIOR INFORMATION

SENIOR DUES: Creekside High School senior dues are \$275 this year and is due on February 14, 2026. This can be made in two payments of \$137.50 (October 15th & February 14th due dates). This fee includes all monies to be paid to Gateway Center Arena to conduct our commencement program. All class trips, activities, and apparel are paid a la carte and NOT a part of the regular senior dues. You may pay on Creekside's OSP webpage. Please know prices will increase second semester. As an incentive, the first 50 students to pay full price will receive TWO additional graduation tickets. Also, students who violate school rules can be placed on the "No Fly List" and become ineligible to participate in senior activities but will still be allowed to participate in commencement.
