<p>Kelly Springs Elementary School will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide instruction through scientifically based programs in reading, math, science, writing, and social studies. 2. Provide teacher training as new programs are implemented to ensure effective instruction is delivered. ● Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement and: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An orientation session will be held before the first day of school to explain the compact. 2. Teachers will contact/meet with parents of at-risk students during each nine weeks to discuss progress. 3. PTO meetings will be held 2 times during the school year. ● Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Weekly papers will be sent home in "Wednesday Folders." 2. Progress reports are sent home mid-term and report cards are sent home at the end of each nine week period. 3. Parents will also be able to sign up for electronic alerts to monitor their child's progress. 4. Parents will be able to access student information through our Parent Portal. ● Provide parents reasonable access to teacher/staff: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Parents will be able to contact teachers/staff through email, phone calls, and notes. 2. Teachers will have designated planning times to be communicated through the school website and monthly newsletter. ● Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class and to observe classroom activities as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Monthly newsletters will provide information on activities that are taking place at school. 2. Parents will be encouraged to volunteer at school. ● Ensure regular two-way, meaningful communication between family members and school staff, to the extent practicable, in a language that family members can understand. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide translation services through our migrant/EL liaison for important information. 2.
