NEMS Families,

In April, students will take the ILEARN Summative Assessment. This is different from the smaller checkpoints given throughout the school year. The ILEARN Checkpoints are shorter assessments used to monitor progress and help teachers adjust instruction in real time. The ILEARN Summative Assessment, given each spring, is a comprehensive end-of-year test that measures how well students have mastered Indiana's academic standards.

It is important that students do their best so we have an accurate reflection of their learning and can support them as they move forward.

Testing dates:

- Thursday, April 16 (Science – 6th grade only)
- Tuesday, April 21 (ELA – all grades)
- Thursday, April 23 (ELA Part 2 – all grades)
- Tuesday, April 28 (Math – all grades)
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Please remind students to get plenty of sleep and to charge their iPads each night before testing.

Students will use headphones or earbuds during ILEARN. These may be corded or Bluetooth, as long as they connect to the student's iPad. If needed, the school will provide them.

Per state guidelines, cell phones, smart watches, and other wireless devices are not permitted in the testing environment. Students will be asked to keep these items in their lockers (or at home) during testing.

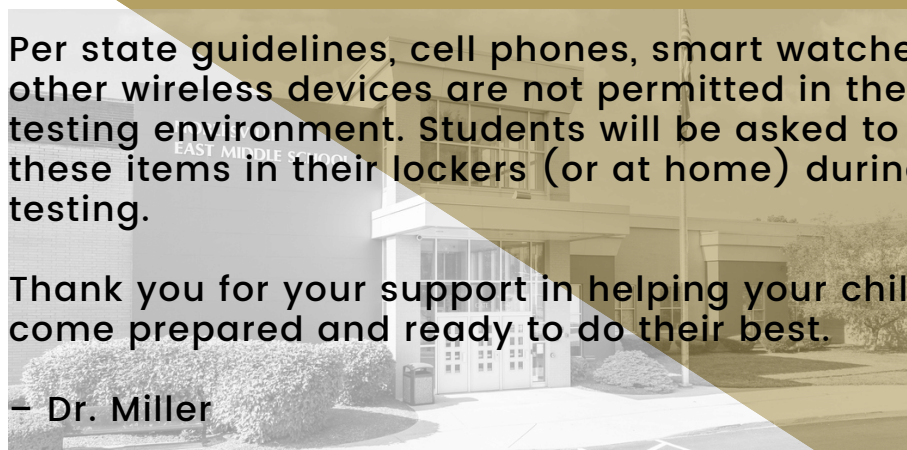

Updated Car Rider Dropoff/pickup AFTER Spring Break

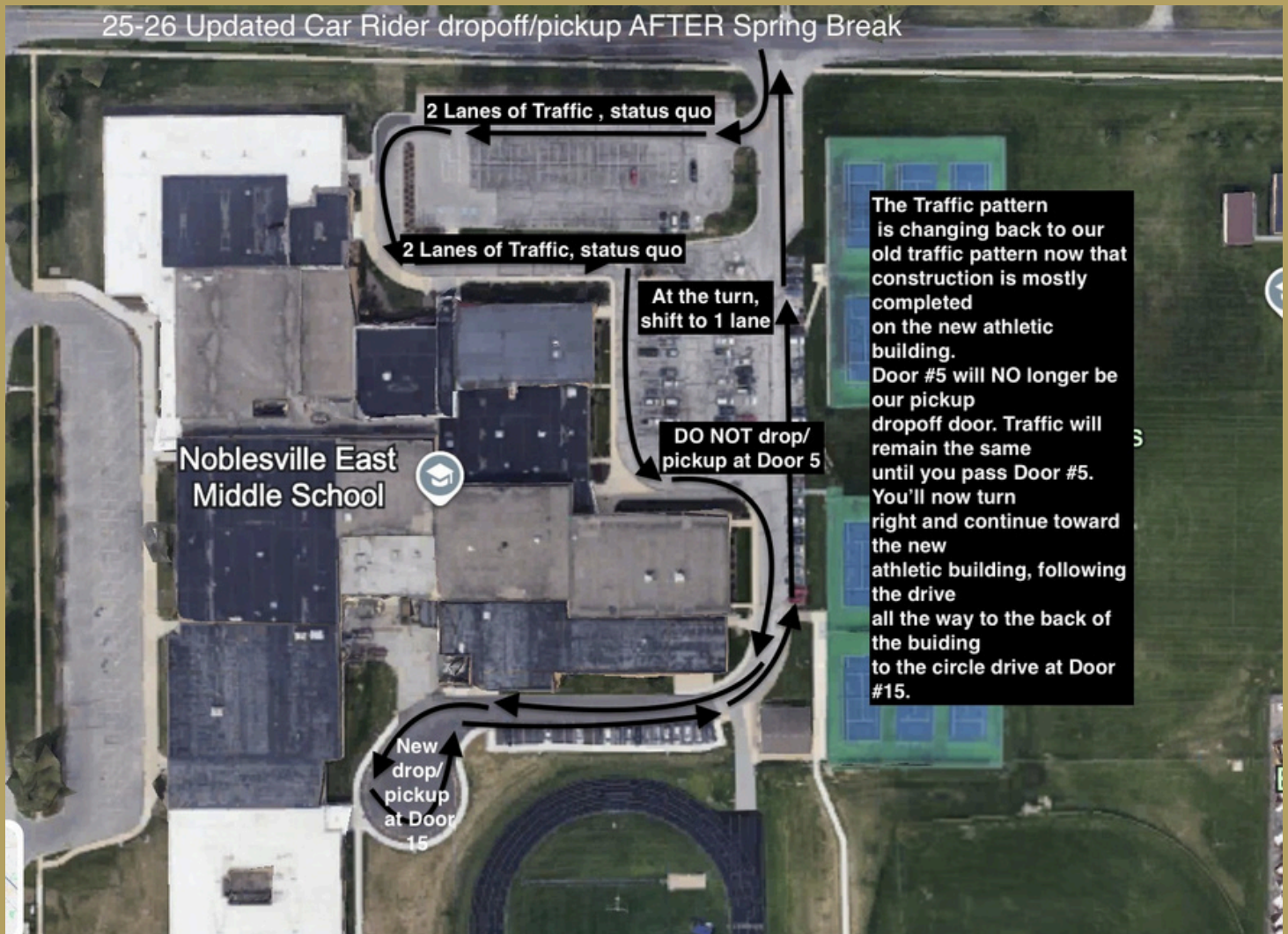
The construction of the new track/football athletic building at the entrance to the track is nearing completion and we are excited for it to open for events this spring.

As a part of the construction completion we will gain access back to our normal car rider drop off and pick up area at Door #15.

Starting Monday, April 13th we will begin using Door #15 again for car riders.

What will that mean for you as a parent? Essentially, you will follow the exact same traffic pattern as we do now - two lanes of traffic passed Door #1 and then merge into a single lane at the same point. However, traffic will now extend to the back of the building passed the football field and track (the location of Door #15).

Counselors Corner

New Student Mental Health Care Resource

We are pleased to announce that effective July 1, 2026 Aspire Indiana Health will be Noblesville Schools' new school-based mental health partner. Every Noblesville school is staffed with school counselors and social workers, and those services will remain in place. Aspire staff will supplement, not replace, the strong mental health supports already available in our schools. This change follows Community Health Network's recent announcement that it will no longer be providing in-school mental health care across the state. Impacted families and staff have received additional details. If you have any questions about school-based mental health resources for students, please contact your school counselor or social worker.



The Indiana 21st Century Scholars Program provides income-eligible students an opportunity to earn a scholarship that could pay up to four years of college tuition and fees. Automatic enrollment has currently taken effect for students on track to graduate high school in 2028 and 2029. Letters to the cohort of 2029 were sent May and August, 2025 to parents and guardians of students who have been automatically enrolled. Parents and guardians can see if their students are automatically enrolled by creating ScholarTrack accounts.

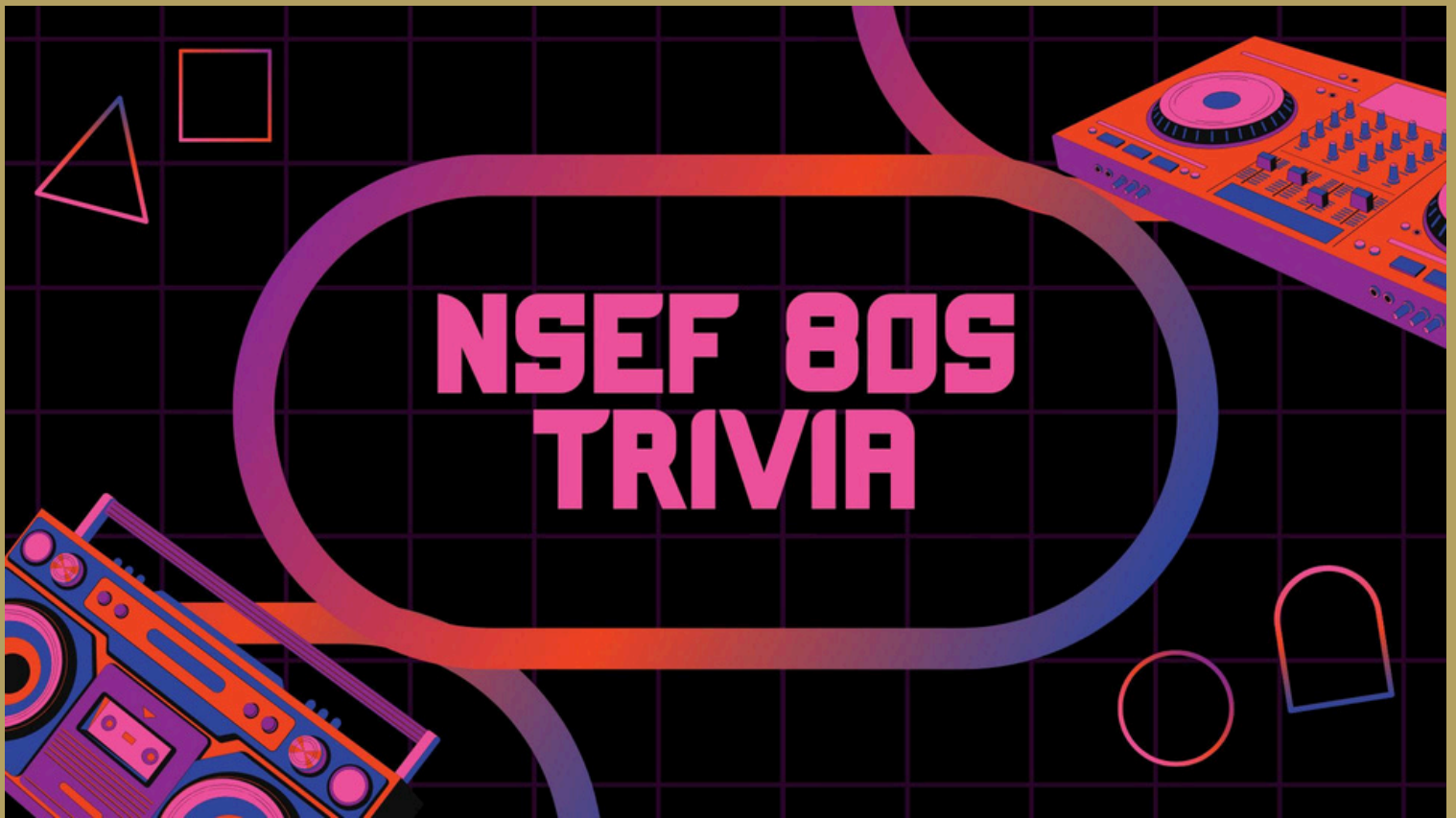
Athletics and Activities

What to Know About Measles

What is Measles?

Measles is a highly contagious virus that can lead to hospitalizations and death especially in young children, older adults, pregnant people, and those with weakened immune systems.

As of March 2026, there are measles outbreaks in many popular spring break destinations including Florida, South Carolina, and Texas.

How Contagious is Measles?

Measles is one of the most contagious infectious diseases known, with up to 90% of unvaccinated individuals near an infected person becoming infected.



What Are The Symptoms?

Measles starts with flu-like symptoms then causes a widespread rash. It can lead to life-threatening complications like brain inflammation and pneumonia.



I Think I Have Measles... What Should I Do?

Isolate yourself immediately, and call your healthcare provider. If the emergency room is needed, call ahead to avoid waiting rooms.


How Do I Know if I'm Protected?

You can check your vaccination status at <https://myvaxindiana.in.gov>. If your vaccines aren't registered, a booster shot will not harm you. Contact your healthcare provider or the Hamilton County Health Department.

How Do I Get Vaccinated?

Talk with your healthcare provider or call the Hamilton County Health Department to receive the MMR vaccine.

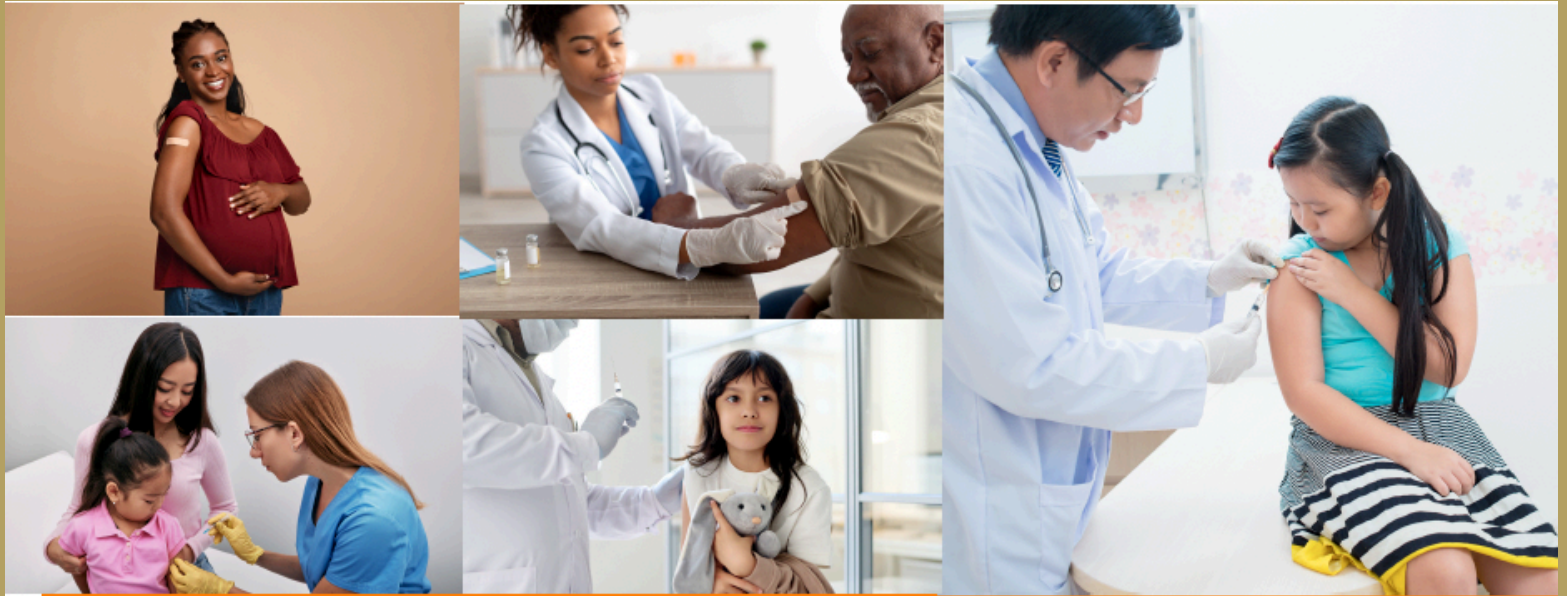

Please send or bring immunization records, if available.

Please bring your insurance cards. We accept and bill all insurance (commercial, Medicare, Medicaid). **There is no cost to those without insurance, except for the Shingles and adult RSV vaccines.**

All vaccines will be provided as available. We will consult the state immunization registry to assess immunization needs. If you would like to refuse a specific vaccine, please contact the Indiana Immunization Coalition at least 48 hours prior to the event at clinic@vaccinateindiana.org.
