RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE

Roseville Joint Union High School District

**DECLARING AN ELECTION BE HELD IN ITS JURISDICTION;
REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO CONSOLIDATE THIS
ELECTION
WITH ANY OTHER ELECTION CONDUCTED ON SAID DATE;
AND
REQUESTING ELECTION SERVICES BY THE COUNTY CLERK.**

WHEREAS, an election will be held within the Roseville Joint Union High School District that will affect

Placer County

WHEREAS, this District Governing Body orders an election to be held in its jurisdiction on

November 3, 2026; at which election the issue(s) to be presented to the voters shall be:

NOMINATION OF CANDIDATES FOR THE GOVERNING BODY

1. The District has two Trustee seats facing election. Said election shall be to fill a vacancy for the following Board Member(s) who resigned and/or whose term(s) expired:

Incumbent's Name	Division Number (if applicable)	Regular/Short Term
Pete Constant	Trustee Area 2	Regular
Marla Franz	Trustee Area 4	Regular

2. The regular terms will expire on the second Friday of December 2026 (December 11, 2026).
3. Said District has determined the following election particulars:
 - The length of the Candidate Statement shall not exceed 200 words.
 - The cost of the Candidate Statement shall be paid by the Candidate.
 - The County Clerk is requested to provide election services and all applicable costs will be paid for by the District.
 - In the case of a tie vote, the election shall be determined by LOT.
4. Said Directors for this District are elected by district. Voters within the District vote for candidates in that district.
5. The District has determined the following election particulars:
 - There have been no District boundary changes since our last election, but the District understands that the Placer County Public Works Mapping Division will verify our District boundary lines prior to the election.
 - The District has drawn new maps with Trustee representation areas. These maps were submitted to Placer County Election in March of 2022.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer is hereby requested to:

1. Consolidate the election with any other applicable election conducted on the same day;
2. Authorize and direct the County Clerk, at Governing Body expense, to provide all necessary election services.

This Resolution shall be considered a Notice of Election and Specification of Election Order if applicable.
