What is a High School Transcript?

Washington State public high schools that serve students who are attempting high school credit are required to use the Washington State Standardized High School Transcript, RCW 28A.230.125.



In Washington State:

- A high school transcript is an **official educational record created under state law**
- An **official transcript is legally recognized and relied upon**
- It functions as a **legal document for verification and evidentiary purposes**, even if statutes use the term *official record* instead of *legal document*
- School districts must retain student transcripts permanently (no destruction date)

What are the components of a High School Transcript?

The transcript document has three primary sections: a header, a body, and a footer.

Header

- Performance in those classes

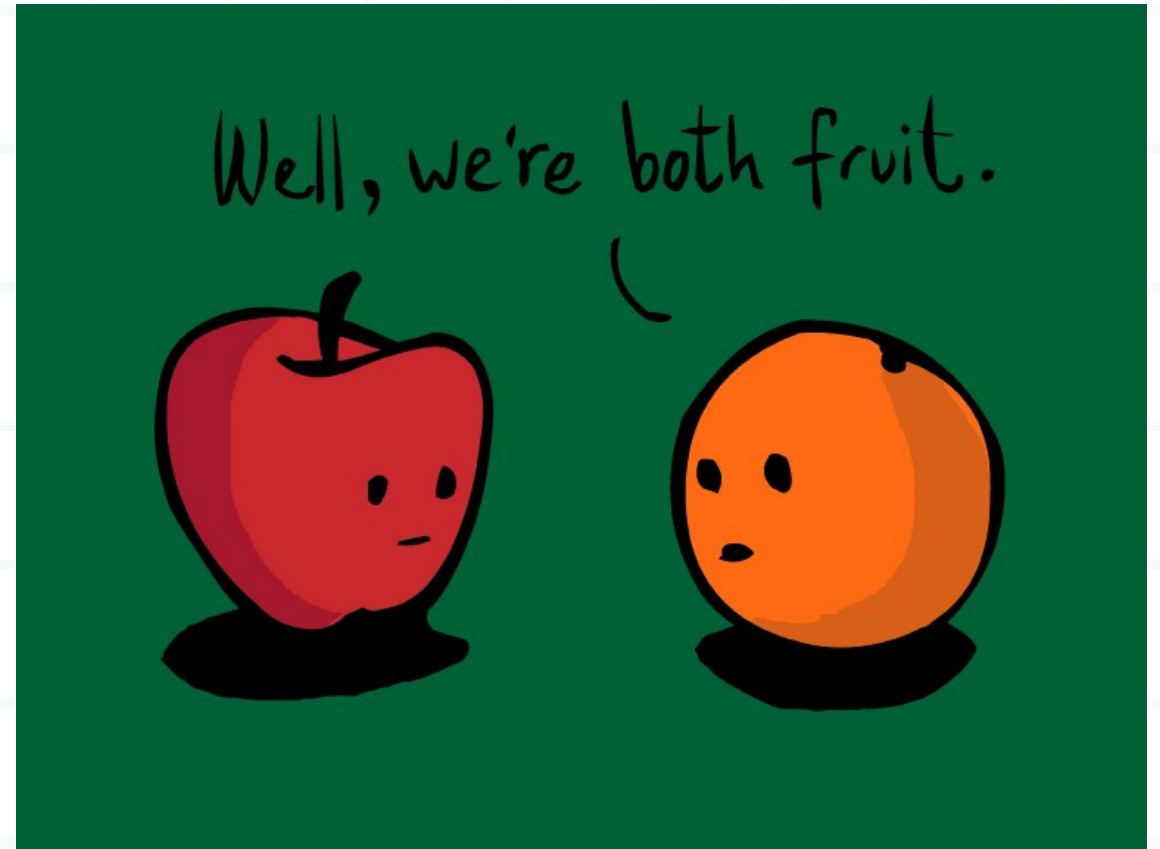
