- Early graduates **must notify** Mrs. Morgan no later than May 1, 2026 if you are planning on participating in the 2026 TFHS Commencement Ceremony.
- All graduates **are required** to attend the rehearsal on May 27, 2026 if you plan to participate in the Commencement Ceremony.
- Graduation gowns, stoles, and NHS attire belong to the high school. Gowns, stoles, and NHS attire must be returned immediately following the ceremony in good condition before the final diploma and transcript are issued.
- Caps, tassels, and honor cords will be purchased by the Class of 2026. Graduates may keep these items.
- Graduates are expected to wear appropriate attire at the Commencement Ceremony. This means that you must be dressed in nice clothing; clean and free of holes. Jeans or jean shorts and flip flops are not allowed. Graduates may wear nice shorts of appropriate length and/or sandals.
- Invitations may be purchased at the Ledger or online through another provider. Consider sending invitations out 2—3 weeks before graduation. You might want to purchase thank you cards as well.
- Each graduate will be allowed **8 guests** in a designated area in the gym or on the football field based on the weather. Others attending the ceremony will be seated elsewhere.
