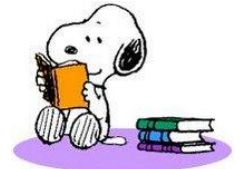




RGS: Bonkers About Books!

you will never know.

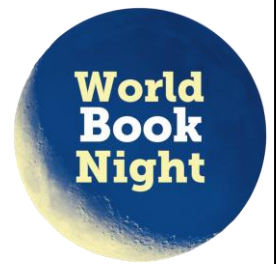
Books can be told or read
