WESTPORT COMMUNITY SCHOOLS PRESCHOOL/PRE-K PROGRAMS 2026-2027

All Westport children who will reach age 3 before September 1, 2026, and are fully toilet-trained, are eligible to attend our Preschool. Children who reach age 4 before September 1, 2026, and are fully toilet-trained, are eligible for our Pre-K program at the Alice A. Macomber School for the 2026-2027 school year. By registering your child, you are confirming that they are fully toilet-trained and ready to attend school. Students who are not fully toilet-trained are not able to attend.

*Preschool and Pre-K registration will be held through May 15, 2026, on a first-come, first-served basis.

Programs for 4-year-olds:

- M, T, W, Th, F (5 Full days) 8:50 AM – 2:15 PM \$780.00/month
- M, W, F (3 Full days) 8:50 AM – 2:15 PM \$475.00/month

Programs for 3-year-olds:

- M, T, W, Th, F (5 Full days) 8:50 AM – 2:15 PM \$780.00/month
- T, Th (2 Full days) 8:50 AM – 2:15 PM \$335.00/month

Our offerings, timeframes, and tuition are subject to change. Offerings depend on a minimum class size. Should the number of enrollments exceed the number of available openings, a waiting list will be created. If you are interested in registering your child to be considered for enrollment, please complete the [Online Enrollment](#) by May 15, 2026, to be considered pre-registered. The Westport Community Schools has implemented the General Eligibility Form. Completing this form can reduce fees for those students who are not identified based on their participation in public assistance programs. The following documents are also needed:

1. Copy of a valid Birth Certificate
2. Updated record of immunization
3. Copy of the most recent physical examination, including record of lead testing and TB screening
4. Copy of parent/guardian driver's license or photo ID
5. Three (3) proofs of residency (see Acceptable Proof of Residence chart)

*Parents/Guardians will be notified of their child's acceptance into the program by May 24, 2026.
