

**PUBLIC NOTICE / INVITATION FOR SEALED PROPOSALS  
TURNKEY PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF RELOCATABLE CLASSROOM  
UNITS**

The Cleveland School District, Cleveland, Mississippi, will receive sealed proposals for the turnkey purchase and installation of relocatable classroom units until 1:00 p.m., Friday, May 15, 2026, at 305 Merritt Drive, Cleveland, MS 38732, at which time proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud or opened as otherwise permitted by law.

The District is soliciting pricing for the following options: (1) Option 1 - one six-classroom unit with restrooms, ADA accessibility, complete installation, removal of two existing double-wide classrooms, skirting, sidewalks, awnings/walk covers, and HVAC installation; (2) Option 2 - one two-classroom unit with restrooms, ADA accessibility, complete installation, removal of one existing double-wide classroom, skirting, sidewalks, awnings/walk covers, and HVAC installation; and (3) Option 3 - two two-classroom units with restrooms, ADA accessibility, complete installation, removal of two existing double-wide classrooms, skirting, sidewalks, awnings/walk covers, and HVAC installation.

Only vendors approved by the Mississippi Department of Education to submit bids on relocatable classrooms in Mississippi shall be eligible to propose. The successful proposal and award shall be subject to all applicable Mississippi laws and all required approvals of the Mississippi Department of Education.

Each proposer is responsible for reviewing the site and the full proposal packet. The Cleveland School District reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, waive informalities, and accept the proposal deemed to be in the best interest of the Cleveland School District, consistent with applicable law.
