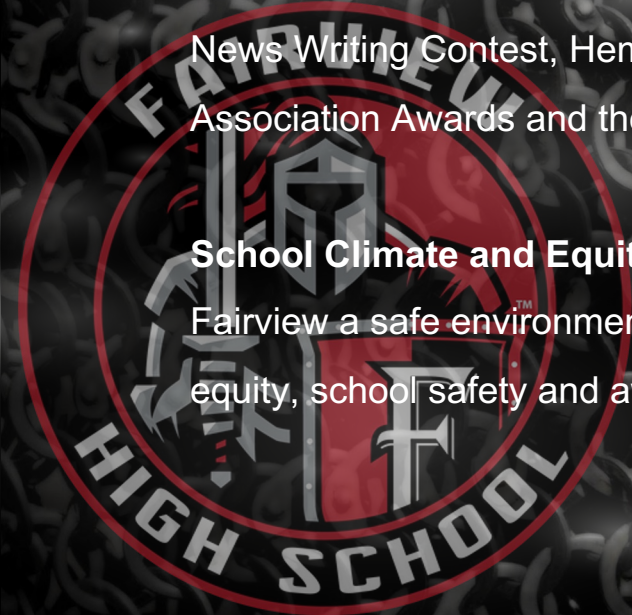
Knight Crew – Students who have been a significant part of the lives of Fairview Freshmen as Knight Crew Leaders are recognized for their considerable contributions.



STUDENT ACTIVITIES AND CLUBS AWARDS

Royal Banner Newspaper – Awards are given both for exceptional performance of duties in publishing the school newspaper, as well as for state competitions such as CSU Journalism Day, Colorado High School Press Association State Awards, Capitol Hill Press Conference News Writing Contest, Hemingway Young Journalists Contests, American Scholastic Press Association Awards and the Denver Post Prep Sports Writing Contest.


School Climate and Equity – Awards are given to students who have worked to make Fairview a safe environment for all students. Their leadership and service to the goal of equity, school safety and awareness has left a positive impact on our school community.

Speech and Debate

- Outstanding Speech and Debate Student: This student is recognized each year for outstanding commitment to the Speech and Debate team as demonstrated through leadership and mentoring, willingness to try new things, and demonstration of outstanding character and effort.
 - Academic All-America: Students who have received the Academic All American award through the National Forensic League are also recognized. For this award, students must meet SAT/ACT and GPA standards, receive personal recommendations from the Principle and coaches, and have received over 750 points with the National Forensics League.

DEPARTMENTAL AWARDS

Business and Computer Science- These awards are given to outstanding students in Business and Computer Science.

Career and Technical Education- The Boulder Technical Education Center Awards recognize outstanding students for their performance in Career and Technical Education Programs.

Counseling

- **The Jeanne Nauenberg Award** - This award is given by the counseling department to a senior who has overcome significant challenges.

Family and Consumer Science- This award is given to a senior who has been in the program for several years and has excelled in their classes.

DEPARTMENTAL AWARDS

Fine Arts - The Fine Arts Department confers awards to students in visual arts, concerts and jazz band, choir, orchestra and theatre (actors and crew). Each area selects outstanding students who have contributed leadership and extra effort and who demonstrate attributes of developing artists, musicians and actors.

Gifted and Talented

- **Youth Impact Award**- Given to GT students, who have made a positive, meaningful, and beneficial impact on others in their classroom, school and/or community.

Language Arts- Awards conferred to outstanding Language Arts students include the Printed Page Award, the Barbara Carlson Award, and the Woolf-Faulkner Award.

Mathematics-These awards are given to the outstanding mathematics students in each grade level and to the Outstanding Math Student of the Year
