The school:

Osaka and Senri International Schools of Kwansei Gakuin are two sister schools situated in north Osaka that share a campus, purpose, and mission. Osaka International School (OIS) is a K-12 school of 270 students that offers the International Baccalaureate (IB) curriculum and Senri International School (SIS) has approximately 500 students following the Japanese middle and high school curriculum approved by the Japanese Ministry of Education. We were founded for the benefit of returnee, national, and international residents of the Kansai region, bringing together the best of Japanese and non-Japanese educational ideas, systems, and techniques. This enables OIS students and faculty to make authentic connections with Japanese culture and traditions, while SIS students and faculty experience a genuinely international environment unavailable at a regular Japanese school. The position

We are looking for an experienced Spanish language teacher who can teach the two-year IB DP Spanish ab initio (beginner level) language acquisition classes to Grade 11 & Grade 12 students in the OIS Diploma Programme, and also beginner, basic, and standard level language acquisition classes to high school students in SIS. (Basic level students are in their second year of studying the language, whilst Standard level students are in their third year.)

Experience with IB DP lesson planning, teaching philosophy, and assessment models will therefore be a strong advantage, however IB training is available to the successful candidate if needed. The ability to adapt content and teaching practices for different levels of ability is essential.

Qualifications & Experience

The successful candidate will have:

- Spanish language teaching experience, preferably an IB or international school.
- Strong communication skills in English, to collaborate with faculty, communicate with parents, and write reports in English.
- A student-centered approach to learning, and experience in differentiating learning.

Salary & Benefits

We offer a competitive rate calculated by the number of classes taught and including holidays. A commuting allowance is also paid. The position is ideally suited to a local resident not in need of relocation, allowances or other benefits that come with a full-time position. The number of teaching hours will be confirmed prior to each term and is subject to change based on the needs of the curriculum. Typically, there will be between 12-14 hours per week per trimester. This is a year-long contract with the possibility of renewal based on the agreement of both parties.
