

GRAYSON HIGH SCHOOL PARKING

*This presentation is required viewing for
completing your parking application process.*

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

Each year parking spaces are always in high demand. We typically have more applicants for parking than we do parking spaces. Please know that the number of parking spaces are limited, and parking is not offered to everyone.

You must be in good standing both **academically** and **disciplinarily** to receive and **keep** your parking pass.

TWO COMPONENTS

Academics: you must pass all your classes. This includes any modified day, Maxwell, Grayson Tech, online, dual enrollment, elective, or work study classes each semester. This applies to both Seniors and Juniors with current parking decals and all rising juniors applying for parking.

For example, if you are applying for parking, you must have passed all of your classes during the spring semester of your sophomore year and continue to uphold these grades for the duration of your parking pass.

Discipline: suspensions or excessive ISS assignments may prevent students from keeping parking privileges. This includes tardies and attendance. This determination will be at the discretion of Administration.

DISCIPLINE – SPECIFIC RULE VIOLATIONS

- Rule 6 – Weapons, Dangerous Instruments, and Explosive or Implosive Devices
- Rule 7 – Drugs, alcohol, and Tobacco, Including Vapes
- Rule 9 – Sexual Misconduct/Indecency
- Rule 10 – Attendance
- Rule 12 – Repeated Violations/Misbehavior/Chronic Disciplinary Incidents
- Attendance – parking privileges may be suspended or revoked for students who fail to follow attendance/tardy rules.

Any misuse of parking privileges including parking in a non-assigned space, reckless driving, not following parking rules, or disrespect of parking lot attendant may result in the loss of parking permit.

Refunds are not given for parking revocation due to discipline or attendance issues.

TICKETS

Tickets will be issued as follows:

1st violation – adhesive ticket will be affixed to your driver side window. Violator will be charged \$25.00 on MyPaymentsPlus.

2nd violation – car subject to towing per administration discretion

Any reproduction of parking decals will result in disciplinary action and a fine of up to \$100.

All tickets must be addressed and paid to clear account for graduation. Non-remittance of parking fines may result in permanent loss of parking privileges.

SPECIAL VEHICLE CIRCUMSTANCES

- Students driving a different vehicle for one day must sign in with parking clerk.
- Students driving a different vehicle for more than one day must receive a temporary pass from the parking clerk.
- Students changing vehicles permanently must register the new vehicle with the parking clerk.

REMINDER

To be in good standing, all students must meet the disciplinary and attendance requirements for the previous semester *before* their application is processed and throughout the retaining of the parking pass.

PARKING PRIORITIES

Parking spaces will be assigned in the following priority:

- 1) Rising Seniors who have applied during the open enrollment dates listed AND are in good standing.
- 2) Rising Juniors who have applied and are in good standing.
- 3) Rising Seniors who apply after the cutoff date and have defaulted to the wait list AND are in good standing.
- 4) Rising Juniors who have been placed on the waiting list and are in good standing.
- 5) 10th graders are not allowed to park on campus.

Reminder: please make sure if you are a rising Senior who qualifies as Dual Enrollment, modified schedule, Maxwell, work-based, Gwinnett Online Campus, and partial home school AND are in good standing that you apply during the initial registration dates to accommodate your travel needs.

PARKING ASSIGNMENTS

Student spaces will be assigned, not chosen.

Special accommodations will be made for students who require a disability parking space. Any additional accommodations will be at the discretion of administration.

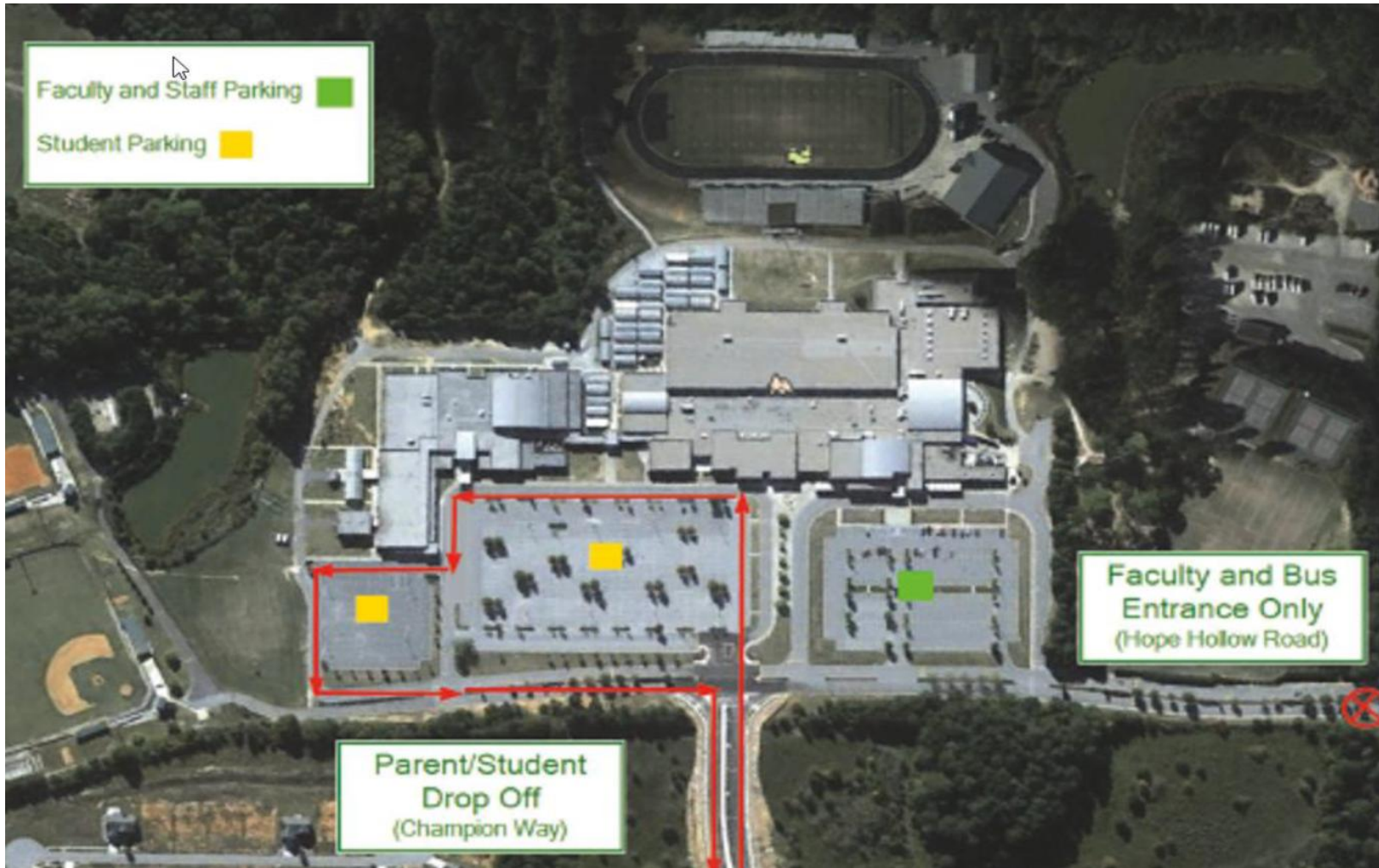
You must show your valid driver's license to pick up your pass.

DECAL ATTACHMENT

Once received, please affix decals to the front driver's side lower windshield for easy viewing in the morning when entering the parking lot.

All students with valid parking passes will enter the Grayson High School campus off Hwy 20 on Champion Way and will follow the traffic pattern indicated to access the student parking lot.

PARKING LOT MAP



Parent and student drivers should enter the GHS campus using Champion Way off of Highway 20. Follow the directional signs for either Parent Drop-Off or Student Parking.

Student parking spots are located across from and to the left of Champion Way. The Hope Hollow Road entrance is for faculty/staff and bus traffic only.
