

Mustang Families,

As we prepare for the 2026–2027 school year, Mustang Public Schools is taking an important step in the evolution of our Mpowered 1:1 technology program.

Beginning next school year, students in Pre-K through 8th grade will transition from individually assigned devices to a classroom-based model, where Chromebooks/iPads are available through shared carts to support daily instruction. Mustang High School students in grades 9 through 12 will continue in the current 1:1 model.

As part of this transition:

- Chromebooks will remain readily available in classrooms to support instruction, collaboration, and student projects
- Devices will no longer be assigned to individual students in Pre-K through 8th grade

This adjustment reflects our continued focus on creating learning environments that are intentional, engaging, and developmentally appropriate. A classroom-based approach allows for more structured, teacher-guided use of technology while supporting collaboration, critical thinking, and meaningful student interaction. It also helps reduce distractions and encourages a balanced approach to learning.

Our commitment to student access to technology remains strong. Devices will continue to play an important role in daily instruction, and students will have access to the tools they need to be successful.

We are proud of the impact the #WeAreMpowered 1:1 program has had in Mustang classrooms and look forward to building on that foundation in ways that best support student learning.
