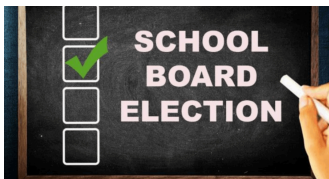

Board of Directors Elections are happening in April. The election will be for a minimum of two and a maximum of three open positions for parents/guardians.

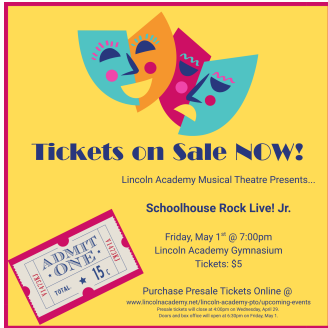
- Qualified applicants will be invited to introduce themselves at the **April 28th** Board of Directors meeting

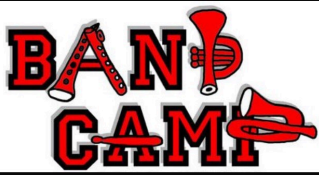
Summer Information
