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Summer Programs Detail

- Breakfast and Lunch will be served.
- Transportation via HPSD Bus Transportation. The buses will leave HHS by 12:00 p.m. If a child is not signed up to ride the bus for summer school, he/she must be picked up by an adult by 12:00 p.m.

Seminar Exploration Description:

- Students will receive Acceleration or Enrichment in the state-tested subject area they will be taking the following school year.
- English Learner (EL) students will receive support to help them grow in both their language proficiency and overall academic achievement.
- Students will receive College and Career Readiness guidance with interactive testing support and strategies for the ACT, WorkKeys, and ASVAB.
- Retired Teachers Writing Project Participation
- Students may take part in educational field trips/guest speakers, depending on their seminar experience.

Credit Recover Description:

The summer school program differs from regular school sessions and is supervised and organized to meet state and district requirements. The following regulations will be in effect for the summer:

1. **PARENT OR GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT TO REGISTER STUDENT!**
2. All Summer School classes will be held on campus. All students will login each morning **NO LATER THAN 8:00 a.m.** each day. Classes will meet *Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.*
3. **Attendance:** STUDENTS are not allowed to miss more than **THREE (3) DAYS**. A 4th day *may be* allowed with documentation of medical or family emergency, or financial hardship.
4. **Discipline:** Absolutely no behavioral issues will be tolerated. Any discipline problems will lead to dismissal from the summer session.
5. **Tardiness:** Entry to summer school after 8:30 a.m. is authorized by parent/guardian only. Arrival after 10:30 a.m. will count as an absence for that day. Three (3) tardies count as one day of absence.
