Educational Supports

➤ IEP Students

- We will be scheduling a transition meeting this year with their current support team.

➤ 504 Plan Students

- We will set up meetings in September/October to transition your student and make sure their accommodations are appropriate for our setting.
- Your student's teacher will receive their middle school 504 plan at the beginning of the year as a starting point.
- If you need us to know something about your student that isn't in the 504, please reach out.
- Be sure to include your student on the check in list if currently on a 504.

- LTC (Life Threatening Conditions)
 - Need paperwork and medication for student to attend the first day of school. Must be turned in at least a week before school starts to ensure plans can be made and distributed to teachers.
- Medications
 - Need paperwork at school for medication administration at school, even for over-the-counter medications. Any medication can be carried by the student at this age, UNLESS it is a controlled substance like most ADHD medications and some anxiety medications. It is best to give medications at home if possible.
- Food Sensitivities
 - If your student has specific dietary needs, there is paperwork for your doctor to fill out.
- Immunizations
 - I will contact you if I am unable to get records.

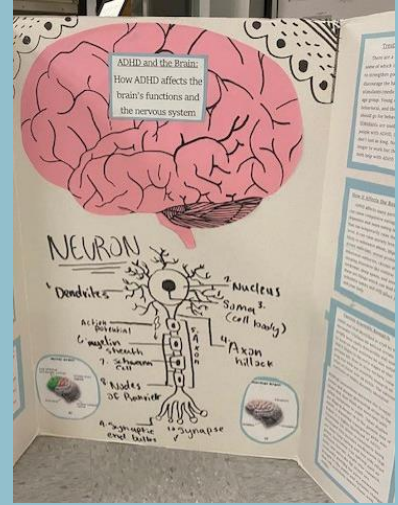

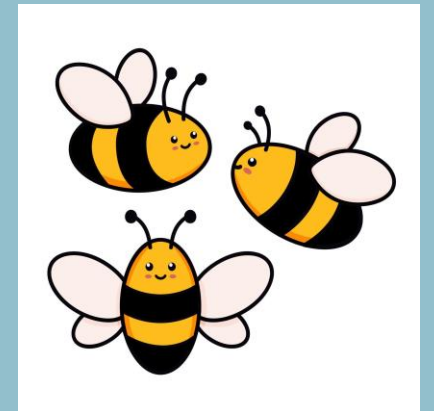

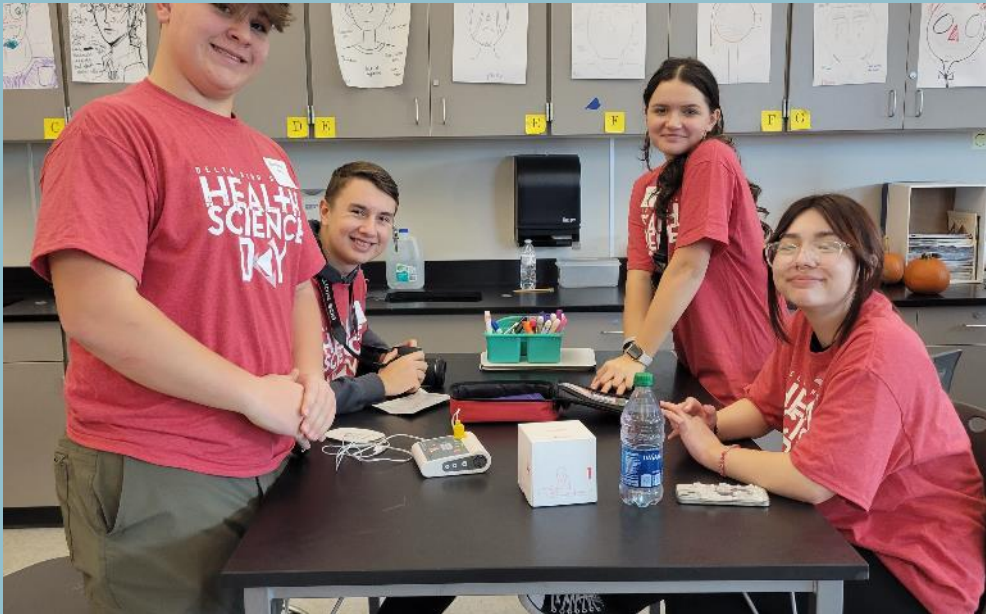
