2- First line item (purchase of notebooks) was increased by \$300. Fourth line item (“additional equipment...” was reduced by \$300. All others left unchanged.  
During discussion, Tatari asked if use of money for planners was necessary given the number of notebooks and planners that students already have. Waggle said that was a good argument but pointed out that using electronic calendars comes with its own problems (familiarity, experience, accessibility). Organization is a component of THS SLO’s and planners are a tool for working towards that goal. It was decided that planner use in 26-27 would be monitored to inform future purchase decisions.

Tatari also asked about a printing service (kiosk) for students as this had been discussed in previous SSC meetings. Waggle explained the printers are ready but the mechanism for allowing student access is being looked at by ISET.
